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## Notes

### Introduction

1. This Business Monitor presents provisional estimates of some of the principal results of the Census of Production for 1979 with comparative data for 1977 and 1978. The monitor includes operating ratios for 1979 calculated from census measures of output, investment, manpower and labour costs. The Report on the Census of Production, 1979, will also be published in the Business Monitor PA series. A full list of proposed monitors appears opposite.

2. Censuses of Production are taken annually for Great Britain by the Department of Industry's Business Statistics Office under the Statistics of Trade Act, 1947 and for Northern Ireland by the Department of Commerce, Belfast, under the Statistics of Trade (Northern Ireland) Act, 1949. The information collected separately for Northern Ireland is included in the United Kingdom totals published in the Business Monitors.

3. The Census of Production forms part of a system of industrial statistics mainly brought into operation between 1970 and 1973. The rest of the system comprises selected monthly inquiries into manufacturers' sales, orders and production, quarterly inquiries into the product sales of manufacturing industries and less frequent inquiries into additional subjects including details of purchases of goods and services by industry.

### Objectives

4. The main objective of the series of annual censuses is to provide information about the structure of industry in the United Kingdom, which will be useful to industry, economic analysts and Government alike and will facilitate international comparisons with other member states of the European Community. The censuses make possible the comparison of the characteristics of an industry either between years or with other industries in the same year.

### Coverage

5. The Censuses for 1977–1979 covered United Kingdom establishments engaged in manufacturing, mining and quarrying, construction, electricity, gas and water supply (Orders II–XXI of the Standard Industrial Classification (revised 1968) (SIC)). In recent censuses returns have been required from all establishments employing 20 or more. For the 1978 and 1979 censuses in 68 selected manufacturing industries coverage of establishments in the 20 to 49 employment size band has been reduced to a 1 in 2 sample. This change has relieved some 5,800 firms of the need to complete a census return. In the construction industry, where firms employing fewer than 20 persons account for a relatively high proportion of total employment and output, a sample was taken of establishments employing fewer than 20 employees.

### Industrial Classification

6. The United Kingdom SIC was first issued in 1948 and was subsequently revised in 1958 and 1968. It exists to promote uniformity and comparability in the official statistics of the United Kingdom. The general principles followed are those of the International Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities of the United Nations Statistical Office but the United Kingdom SIC reflects the organisation and structure of industry and trade as it exists in the United Kingdom. The SIC is a classification by activity and is not a commodity classification. However, an index of all commodity headings for which sales data are provided in the Quarterly Business Monitors is published in Business Monitor PO1000.

### Period covered

7. Establishments were asked to make returns in respect of the calendar year but a return for a business year ending on any date from 6 April 1979 to 5 April 1980 was accepted. Returns covering less than twelve months were accepted in those cases where businesses had started or ceased during the year.

### Estimation

8. The provisional results include estimates, as will the final results, for non-respondents, unsatisfactory returns and establishments not required to make returns.

### Symbols used

9. The following symbols are used throughout the PA series of Business Monitors:

- \* figures cannot be shown owing to the risk of disclosing information about individual enterprises

### Rounding of figures

10. Figures in the tables have, where necessary, been rounded to the nearest final digit.

### Collection of data

11. Questionnaires for the 1979 Census were despatched in January 1980 and computer generated reminder letters were despatched during May, June and August, 1980. If the reminders failed to produce a response, establishments whose figures are of particular importance to the inquiry are contacted by telex, telephone or a personal visit. Every effort is made to persuade establishments to provide returns promptly.

### Response

12. The estimates for 1979 in Tables 1 and 2 are based on questionnaires received at the Business Statistics Office up to the end of September 1980.

The response for each industry, based on employment, is indicated in Table 1. Response is estimated to cover per cent of total employment in manufacturing industries.

#### Results

13. Final results of the 1979 Census, including analyses by size of establishment and by region will appear in 164 separate industry Business Monitors (PA series). Publication of the monitors will begin in the second quarter of 1981. Compilation of the final results for the 1977 Census has been completed and all industry monitors have been published. Publication of 1978 final results commenced in the third quarter of 1980. Tables 1 and 2 give comparative data for 1977–1979. The results for 1977 are compiled from the final industry monitors for 1977. The 1978 results are final with the exception of a few industries for which provisional results are only available. An indication of the likely size of revisions between provisional and final results is given in Table 3. This table has been compiled from the census results for 1975–1977. Table 4 – the operating ratios shown in this table are provisional estimates only. Final figures for these ratios will appear in the separate industry Business Monitors.

#### EXPLANATION OF TERMS USED

##### Employment

14. Establishments were required to state the average number of persons on the payroll during the year of return. Separate figures were required for:

- (a) administrative, technical and clerical employees
- (b) all other employees (operatives)

Establishments were also required to state the number of working proprietors where appropriate and these are included in total employment figures. Full-time and part-time employees are included but outworkers (i.e. persons employed by establishments who worked in their own homes etc., on materials supplied by the establishment) are excluded.

##### Gross output

15. In the calculation of gross output the value of total sales and work done is increased by the rise (or reduced by the fall) during the year in the value of work in progress and goods on hand for sale.

##### Net output

16. Net output, a customary census measure, is calculated by deducting from gross output the cost of purchases (reduced by the rise or increased by the fall, during the year, of stocks of materials etc.) and the cost of industrial services received, and where applicable, duties etc.

##### Gross value added at factor cost

17. Gross value added at factor cost is calculated by deducting from net output the cost of non-industrial services (rent of buildings, hire of plant and machinery, commercial insurance premiums, bank charges and amounts paid for professional services, post office services, transport and advertising), rates (excluding water rates) and the cost of licensing motor vehicles. This estimate of gross value added approaches more closely than census net output to the definition of net output or value added in national accounts statistics.

Gross value added data may be used in conjunction with other census results to derive operating ratios providing measures of industrial performance. Of particular interest is gross value added per head, which is derived by dividing the gross value added by the average number of persons employed (full and part-time) on all activities covered by the returns, including operatives, administrative, technical and clerical employees and working proprietors, but excluding outworkers.

##### Operating ratios

18. For each industry the operating ratios shown were obtained by dividing the estimate of the industry total for the quantity shown in the numerator by the corresponding estimate of the quantity shown in the denominator. These estimates cover all establishments classified to each industry, including not selected establishments and non-respondents. In comparing the ratios between different industries, consideration must be given to the nature of the business carried on by firms in the industries concerned. Within an industry, it is possible to compare ratios for an individual firm with the ratios shown for the relevant industry. However, it is important to bear in mind that various factors may affect the results – for example, differences in definitions, treatment of depreciation (which is not identified in the census data) and varying practice with regard to stock valuation, may affect comparability in some respects.

19. Business Monitor PA1001 – Introductory Notes sets out in greater detail the notes for guidance and explanation of how a census is conducted.

An indication of the size of revisions is given in this table which is based on a comparison of provisional and final results of the censuses for 1975–1977. 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The results of most of the inquiries conducted by the Business Statistics Office are published as Business Monitors. Many firms find these Monitors useful when making decisions. They can give you information about manufacturing industries, their markets and the industries they buy from, and about the retail and wholesale trades.

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The Department of Industry and the Business Statistics Office jointly produce two publications which contain price index numbers which could be used for CCA purposes. "Price index numbers for Current Cost Accounting" (issue number 13) was published in April 1980 by HMSO, price £7.50, and provides historical series of price index numbers up to February 1980 for plant and machinery bought as fixed assets by specific industries, stocks held by specific industries, specific types of asset, and buildings and works. The retail price index is also included. A full explanation of the purpose, content and method of compiling the indices is given in this publication only.

The latest index numbers for the series available in the above publication are published each month in Business Monitor MM17 "Price index numbers for Current Cost Accounting (monthly supplement)". This is available from HMSO, PO Box 569, London SE1 9NH, price £9.85 for 12 consecutive copies.
