INDEX OF PRODUCTS

The index of products contained in the following pages indicates, by reference to the list of volumes on the next page, the Industry Report in which details of the output of a particular commodity are shown. The page indicated is that on which appears the figure for total sales of the commodity in 1954 by the larger firms (and in a very few cases the smaller firms also) engaged in its production.

The omission of a commodity from the index does not necessarily mean that there was no production in the United Kingdom during 1954, but merely that sales are not separately recorded in the Census reports.

Some items included in the index do not appear separately in the reports, but only as part of a wider group of commodities. Such cases occur where objection was made to the publication of separate figures on account of the disclosure of information relating to individual undertakings.

The index covers only the sales of particular products and not their purchase by other industries in which they are used. Information on such purchases in Table 9 of the individual industry reports has not been indexed.
