#### OILS AND GREASES TRADE

THIS REPORT on the Oils and Greases Trade relates to establishments engaged wholly or mainly in blending mineral, animal or vegetable lubricating oils (except at refineries), in the production of cycle and motor oils, cart grease, etc., and of dripping, suet, tallow, premier jus, oleo-stearine, and other animal (except marine animal) oils, fats and greases (except lard) and in the production and refining of fish liver oil.

This trade corresponds to minimum list headings 39(1) and 39(3) in the Standard Industrial Classification.

Any establishments in this trade in Northern Ireland are excluded in 1948. Owing to the risk of disclosure of information relating to individual firms, separate particulars of the very small output in Northern Ireland were not published for 1935.
