PART V.—ORPHANHOOD (EUROPEANS).

INTRODUCTORY NOTES.

The statistics published in this volume are the first of their kind to be collected and tabulated in the Union of South Africa. The tables are compiled from the question which appeared on the Census form as follows:—

- For children under 15 years of age:
- If both parents living, write 1.
 - If father be dead, write 2.
 - If mother be dead, write 3.
 - If both parents be dead, write 4.

NOTE.—“Father” and “Mother” do not include step-parents or parents by adoption.

It will be seen that the tables deal only with children under 15 years of age. These numbered 584,096 and formed 34.84 per cent. of the total European population. No information was given on the forms in respect of 2,185 children, or less than 4 in every 1,000.

Although the statistics deal primarily with orphans or children who have lost one or both parents, some of the tables also show the number of children whose parents were both living. These are inserted for the purpose of comparison and also to enable proportions to be gauged.

Out of the 581,911 for whom particulars were given, 3,773 had lost both parents, and 54,266 had lost one parent. Of the latter, 33,935 had lost the father but not the mother, leaving 20,331 who had lost the mother but not the father. Expressed in proportions of a *thousand*, 6.5 were parentless, 58.1 were fatherless, and 34.8 motherless, while 896.9 had both parents living.

As this is the first occasion on which these statistics have been collected in the Union, there exists no standard by which they may be measured. It is therefore necessary to make comparison with other countries which have collected similar data. New Zealand also collected particulars of orphanhood in 1926 and, as the statistics have recently been published, the following table has been prepared. In New Zealand, particulars were collected for children under 16 years; but in order to make the comparison with the Union effective, only those under 15 years of age are shown in the table.

In calculating these proportions, those who did not specify particulars of their parents were excluded. For this reason the percentages here given for the Union differ slightly from those given in Table 1. Owing to the greater numbers in the population of the Union, the figures in the above table do not afford a very good comparison, but by expressing them in percentages it will be seen that there are relatively more orphans in the Union than in New Zealand.

Table 2 shows the individual ages of all orphans in single years. The figures reveal a fairly normal graduation with no striking features. As the ages advance the number of cases of one or both parents dead increases, which is to be expected. Of the infants under 1 year of age, 23 were completely orphaned and 454 had lost one parent. At the other end of the table, at 14 years of age, 550 were completely orphaned and 6,572 had lost one parent. This table also shows the urban and rural distribution; but although 11.8 per cent. of the children in urban areas were orphans, as against 7.7 per cent. in rural areas, this may be due largely to the fact that Orphanages are usually situated in urban areas.

Table 3 shows the geographical distribution of orphans throughout the magisterial districts of the Union, and table 8 the numbers in the principal towns. 33.5 per cent. of all orphans, and 38 per cent. of completely orphaned children, were enumerated in the ten largest towns of the Union.

In regard to sex distribution there was an extraordinarily even balance as the following figures show; but in relation to the total number of children of each sex, there was a greater proportion of female than male orphans:—

There was almost an equal number of boys and girls completely orphaned, and of those who had lost their mother there was a small excess of 43 boys; but of those who were fatherless the excess of boys was nearly 500.

DEEL V.—EUROPESE WEESKINDERS.

INLEIDENDE OPMERKINGE.

Die gegewens in hierdie deel opgeneem, is die eerste van hierdie aard wat in die Unie van Suid-Afrika ingesamel en getabelleer is. Die tabelle is opgemaak van die antwoorde op die volgende vraag, wat op die Sensusvorm voorgekom het:—

Vir kinders onder 15 jaar oud:—

As beide ouers lewe, vul in 1.
As die vader dood is, vul in 2.
As die moeder dood is, vul in 3.
As die ouers albei dood is, vul in 4.

NOTA.—“Vader” en “Moeder” sluit nie stiefouers of aangenome ouers in nie.

Opgemerksal word dat die tabelle alleen handel oor kinders onder 15 jaar oud. Hulle aantal was 584,096 of 34·84 persent van die totale Europese bevolking. Met betrekking tot 2,185 kinders, d.i. minder as vier in elke 1,000, was geen informasie verskaf.

Hoewel die gegewens in die eerste plek handel met weeskinders of kinders wat een of beide ouers verloor het, toon sommige van die tabelle ook die aantal kinders aan waarvan beide ouers nog geleef het. Hierdie opgawe is bygevoeg vir die doel van vergelyking en om 'n denkbild te kry van die verhoudinge.

Van die orige 581,911 kinders waarvan gegewens verstrek is, het 3,773 albei hulle ouers verloor, en 54,266 een ouer dood. Van laasgenoemde het 33,935 kinders hulle vader alleen verloor en nie hulle moeder nie, sodat daar 20,331 was wat alleen hulle moeder verloor had. Uitgedruk in verhoudinge per duisend was 6·5 ouderloos, 58·1 was vaderloos en 34·8 moederloos, terwyl 896·9 nog albei hulle ouers had.

Aangesien dit die eerste keer is waarop sulke opgawe in die Unie ingesamel is, bestaan daar geen maatstaf nie waarby die gegewens kan vergelyk word. Dit is dus nodig om vergelyking te maak met ander lande wat soortgelyke gegewens ingesamel het. In 1926 het Nu-Seeland ook opgawe met betrekking tot ouderloosheid ingesamel en aangesien die gegewens onlangs gepubliseer is, is die volgende tabel opgemaak. In Nu-Seeland is opgawe ingesamel omtrent kinders onder 16 jaar oud, dog om die vergelyking met die Unie so suiwer moontlik te maak, is alleen die kinders onder 15 jaar oud in die tabel opgeneem.

By die berekening van hierdie verhoudinge is die kinders waartrent geen opgawe ingekom het nie, buite rekening gelaat. Vandaar dat die persentasies wat hier vir die Unie gegee is, 'n weinig verskil van die in tabel 1. Weens die groter hoeveelhede in die Unie-bevolking verskaf die gegewens in bostaande tabel geen besonder-goeie vergelyking nie, dog uit die persentasies blyk dat daar betreklik meer wese in die Unie is as in Nu-Seeland.

Tabel 2 toon die leeftyd aan van alle weeskinders. Die syfers openbaar 'n taamlik normale toestand met geen opvallende afwykinge nie. By hoër leeftyd neem die aantal gevalle waarin een of beide ouers dood is, toe, soos verwag kan word. Van die suiglinge onder een jaar oud was 28 geheel ouderloos en 454 had een ouer verloor. Uit die ander end van die tabel blyk dat van die kinders, oud 14 jaar, 550 geheel ouderloos was, terwyl 6,572 een ouer verloor had. Hierdie tabel toon ook die verspreiding aan oor stedelike gebied en platteland; dog hoewel 11·8 persent van die kinders in stedelike gebied ouderloos is teen 7·7 persent op die platteland, kan dit grotelijks toegeskrywe word aan die omstandigheid dat die weeshuise gewoonlik in stedelike gebied geleë is.

Uit Tabel 3 blyk die aardrykskundige distribusie van wese oor die magistratuatsdistrikte van die Unie, terwyl Tabel 8 die aantalle aangee in die vernaamste stede. In die tien grootste Unie-stede is 33·5 persent gedeeltelik-ouderlose en 38 persent geheel ouderlose kinders opgeneem.

Met betrekking tot geslagsverdeling blyk uit die volgende opgawe 'n eienaardige ewenwig; dog wat die totaal aantal kinders van elke geslag betref, was daar 'n groter verhouding vroulike as manlike weeskinders.

Daar was byna eweveel seuns as meisies geheel ouderloos, en van die wat hulle moeder verloor had, was daar 43 seuns meer as meisies, terwyl daar byna 500 meer seuns was wat hulle vader verloor had.
