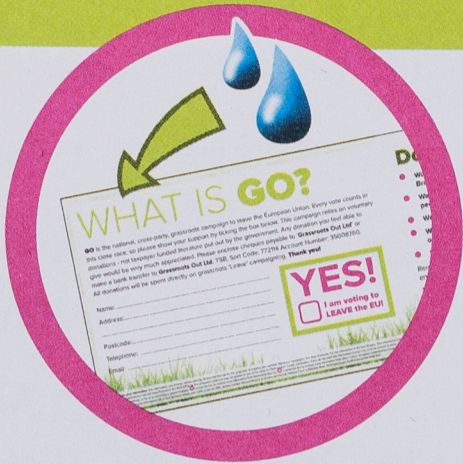

Conservative MP, the Rt Hon Dr Liam Fox, sets out the case for leaving...

In the 1975 referendum people were told that the common market was simply about trade and economics. We now know that was a con and we have been sold into a political project where the European Court can overrule our democratically elected Parliament at Westminster.

We are unable to control our borders and £350million worth of taxpayers money every week is spent on Brussels' priorities, not our own. People are rightly worried that they may be conned again if they vote to stay in. One of the biggest dangers lies in defence where the EU has big ambitions. Recent plans for a European army will undermine our security by weakening NATO and the transatlantic alliance.

We must be willing to cooperate on security with other European countries, but we must never allow the decision to send British forces into harm's way to be taken outside our own shores.
