



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VOORWOORD

Hierdie verslag is die eerste van twee verslae wat Boekdeel 11 uitmaak in die reeks verslae oor die Bevolkingsensus wat op 6 September 1960 gehou is. Dit bevat gegewens ten opsigte van Blanke gesinne en toon besonderhede aan van die grootte van gesinne, gesinstruktuur, gesinsinkomste en ander karakteristieke vir:

- (a) stede, dorpe en plattelandse gedeeltes van elke landdrosdistrik;
- (b) metropolitaanse gebiede en uitgesoekte munisipaliteite; en
- (c) Suid-Afrika en provinsies.

Gegewens ten opsigte van Kleurling- en Asiaatgesinne word in die tweede verslag van Boekdeel 11 gepubliseer. Gegewens met betrekking tot Bantoegeesinne is nie met die Bevolkingsensus van 1960 vergemel nie.

'n Lys van verslae wat reeds ten opsigte van die Bevolkingsensus van 1960 gepubliseer is, verskyn onder "Bibliografie" net na die Verduidelikende Opmerkings.

PREFACE

This report is the first of two reports which comprise Volume 11 in the series of reports on the Population Census which was taken on 6 September 1960. The report contains information in respect of White families, and particulars relating to the size of families, family structure, family income and other characteristics are shown for:-

- (a) cities, towns and rural portions of each magisterial district;
- (b) metropolitan areas and selected municipalities; and
- (c) South Africa and provinces.

Information in respect of Coloured and Asiatic families will be published in the second report of Volume 11. Data regarding Bantu families were not collected at the 1960 Population Census.

VERDUIDELIKENDE OPMERKINGS

1. BASIS VAN OPNAME

In teenstelling met vorige verslae oor die Bevolkingsensus van 1960 word die inligting oor gesinne in hierdie verslag op 'n deure-grondslag aangegee, dit wil sê, persone wou aangeroon volgens die plek waar hulle woonagtig was. Die volgende insluitings en uitsluitings moet in aanmerking geneem word:

- (a) Waar moontlik is Suid-Afrikaanse gesinne of lede van Suid-Afrikaanse gesinne wat op sensusdag in die buiteland was in die tabelle ingesluit;
- (b) vreemde besoekers opgeneem ten tyde van die sensus word nie in hierdie verslag ingesluit nie;
- (c) lede van die diplomatieke dienste van ander lande is nie opgeneem nie.

2. DIE BEGRIP "GESIN"

Vir die doel van die sensus van 1960 is 'n gesin omskryf as 'n man en vrou; of man en vrou en ongetroude kind(ers); of 'n vader en ongetroude kind(ers); of 'n moeder en ongetroude kind(ers). Die benaming "kinders" sluit stiefkinders en aangenome kinders in. Lede van die gesin wat tydelik van die huis afwesig was, soos kinders op kosskool, is ingesluit, dog ouer kinders wat reeds die huis permanent verlaat het, soos dié wat elders werkzaam was, is weggelaat.

Ander familiebetrekkinge van die man of vrou, soos 'n weduweemoeder, 'n geskeide vader, 'n broer, oom, kleinkind, ens., is nie as lede van die gesin beskou nie.

3. DIE BEGRIP "GESINSINKOMSTE"

Vir die doel van die sensus is gesinsinkomste die gesamentlike inkomste van die man en vrou. Waar 'n gesin egter slegs uit die vader en kind(ers) of moeder en kind(ers) bestaan, is die gesinsinkomste dié van daardie vader of van daardie moeder, na gelang van die geval.

4. TABELLE VIR STEDE, DORPE EN PLATTELANDSE GEDEELTES VAN ELKE LANDDROSDISTRIK

- (a) Slegs daardie gebiede waar daar wel gevalle voorkom, is in hierdie tabelle aangetoon.
- (b) As gevolg van afronding tel die gemiddeldes nie altyd op na die aangetoonde totaal nie.

5. TABELLE VIR METROPOLITAANSE GEBIEDE EN UITGESOEKTE DORPE

Die gebiede wat in hierdie tabelle aangetoon word, sluit in alle dorpe met 'n bevolking van meer as 40,000 (alle rasse), sowel as Nigel, Westonaria en Odendaalsrus - Allanridge. Laasgenoemde drie gebiede is aangetoon om die Rand en O.V.S.-goudveld volledig te maak.

'n Metropolitaanse gebied word in die algemeen omskryf as 'n stedelike kompleks wat bestaan uit 'n moedermunisipaliteit en aangrensende gebiede wat stedelik van aard is en wat ekonomies en maatskaplik aan die moederstad gekoppel is.

Die geografiese samestelling van sekere van die gebiede word hieronder omskryf. Die gebiede waarvan die samestelling nie omskryf is nie, bestaan slegs uit die munisipale gebiede van daardie bepaalde sentrums.

Benoni-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die hele landdrosdistrik Benoni.

Bloemfontein-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die munisipale gebied van Bloemfontein en al die aangrensende stedelike gebiede binne die landdrosdistrik Bloemfontein.

Boksburg-munisipaliteit. - Die hele landdrosdistrik Boksburg.

Brakpan-munisipaliteit. - Die hele landdrosdistrik Brakpan.

Kaapstad-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die landdrosdistrikte Bellville, die Kaap, Simonstad en Wynberg.

Durban-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die hele landdrosdistrik Durban; die volgende gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Inanda: Glenashley, Duff's Road, Glen Anil, Newlands, Kwa Mashu; die volgende gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Pinetown: Pinetown, New Germany, Westville, Kloof, Yellow Wood Park, Cavendish, Clermont, Mhlatzana; en die volgende gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Umlazi: Reunion, Umlazi.

Oos-Londen-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die munisipale gebied van Oos-Londen en die aangrensende stedelike gebiede van Beaconsfield, Bonzaai, Buffalo, Eureka, Reeston en Collendale.

Germiston-metropolitaanse gebied. - Germiston, Alberton, Edenvale, Elsburg, Bedford View en die res van die distrik, uitgesonderd Glenhazel, Glenhazel No. 1, Senderwood en Essexwold, en Viewcrest.

Johannesburg-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die hele landdrosdistrik Johannesburg; die volgende gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Germiston: Glenhazel, Glenhazel No. 1, Senderwood en Essexwold, Viewcrest; die volgende gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Kempton Park: Bergvallei, Klipfontein, Lombardy; en die volgende gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Roodepoort: Northcliff, Blackheath, Fairland, Berario.

Kempton Park-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die volgende gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Kempton Park: Kempton Park, Modderfontein, Rietfontein, Kaalfontein en Tembisa.

Kimberley-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die stedelike gebiede van Kimberley, Homestead, Kenilworth en Ronald's Vlei.

Odendaalsrus - Allanridge-metropolitaanse gebied. - Alle stedelike gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Odendaalsrus.

Pietermaritzburg-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die volgende gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Pietermaritzburg: Pietermaritzburg, Hilton Road, Lincoln Mead, Sweetwaters, Winterskloof, Cleland, Dunveria, Edendale, Hollingwood, Ockertskraal.

Port Elizabeth-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die munisipale gebied van Port Elizabeth en die aangrensende stedelike gebiede van Walmer en Bethelsdorp.

Pretoria-metropolitaanse gebied. - Alle stedelike gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Pretoria behalwe Clayville en Irene.

Springs-metropolitaanse gebied. - Die hele landdrosdistrik Springs.

Virginia-metropolitaanse gebied. - Alle stedelike gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Virginia.

Welkom-metropolitaanse gebied. - Alle stedelike gebiede in die landdrosdistrik Welkom.

6. AFWYKINGS IN GEGEWENS

In sommige gevalle bestaan daar verskille tussen die syfers van ooreenstemmende items in verskillende tabelle. Hierdie verskille word toegeskryf aan die metode van masjinalle verwerking van die gegevens. In die meeste gevalle is die verskille relatief klein en dus onbelangrik. Die "verskille" word deur 'n plus-(+) of minusteken (-) onderaan die totaal van elke betrokke tabel aangedui. Hierdie verskil bygetel by of afgetrek van die totaal van die getabelleerde syfers gee die werklike totaal.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. BASIS OF SURVEY

In contrast with previous reports on the 1960 Population Census, information regarding families is given in this report on a de jure basis, that is, persons are shown according to their place of residence. The following inclusions and exclusions must be taken into account:-

- Where possible, South African families or members of South African families who were abroad on census day have been included in the tables;
- foreign visitors enumerated at the time of the census are not included in this report;
- members of the diplomatic corps of other countries were not enumerated.

2. THE CONCEPT "FAMILY"

For the purpose of the 1960 census a family was defined as husband and wife; or husband and wife and unmarried child(ren); or father and unmarried child(ren); or mother and unmarried child(ren). The term "children" includes stepchildren and adopted children. Members of the family who were temporarily absent from home, such as children at boarding school, are included, but older children who had already left home permanently, for example those working elsewhere, have been excluded.

Other relatives of the husband or wife, such as a widowed mother, a divorced father, a brother, uncle, grandchild, etc., were not regarded as members of the family.

3. THE CONCEPT "FAMILY INCOME"

For the purpose of the census, family income is the joint income of the husband and wife. Where a family consists only of the father and child(ren) or mother and child(ren), however, the family income is that of the father or that of the mother, as the case may be.

4. TABLES FOR CITIES, TOWNS AND RURAL PORTIONS OF EACH MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT

- Only those areas in which cases were actually recorded are shown in these tables.
- Due to rounding-off, averages do not always add up to the totals shown.

5. TABLES FOR METROPOLITAN AREAS AND SELECTED TOWNS

The areas shown in these tables include all towns with a population of more than 40,000 (all races), as well as Nigel, Westonaria and Odendaalsrus - Allanridge. The last three areas are shown in order to complete the Rand and O.F.S. Goldfields.

A metropolitan area is generally defined as an urban complex consisting of a parent municipality and adjoining areas which are urban in character and which are economically and socially linked with the parent town.

The geographical composition of certain areas is defined hereunder: (The areas of which the composition is not defined, consist only of the municipal areas of these specific centres).

Benoni metropolitan area. - The whole of the magisterial district of Benoni.

Bloemfontein metropolitan area. - The municipal area of Bloemfontein and all the adjoining urban areas within the magisterial district of Bloemfontein.

Boksburg Municipality. - The whole of the magisterial district of Boksburg.

Brakpan Municipality. - The whole of the magisterial district of Brakpan.

Cape Town metropolitan area. - The magisterial districts of Bellville, the Cape, Simonstown and Wynberg.

Durban metropolitan area. - The whole of the magisterial district of Durban; the following areas in the magisterial district of Inanda: Glenashley, Duff's Road, Glen Anil, Newlands, Kwa Mashu; the following areas in the magisterial district of Pinetown: Pinetown, New Germany, Westville, Kloof, Yellow Wood Park, Cavendish, Clermont, Mhlathuzana; and the following areas in the magisterial district of Umlazi: Reunion, Umlazi.

East London metropolitan area. - The municipal area of East London and the adjoining urban areas of Beaconsfield, Bonza Bay, Buffalo, Eureka, Reeston and Collondale.

Germiston metropolitan area. - Germiston, Alberton, Edenvale, Elsburg, Bedford View and the remainder of the district, excluding Glenhazel, Glenhazel No. 1, Senderwood and Essexwold, and Viewcrest.

Johannesburg metropolitan area. - The whole of the magisterial district of Johannesburg; the following areas in the magisterial district of Germiston: Glenhazel, Glenhazel No. 1, Senderwood and Essexwold, Viewcrest; the following areas in the magisterial district of Kempton Park: Bergvallei, Klipfontein, Lombardy; and the following areas in the magisterial district of Roodepoort: Northcliff, Blackheath, Fairland, Berario.

Kempton Park metropolitan area. - The following areas in the magisterial district of Kempton Park: Kempton Park, Modderfontein, Rietfontein, Kaalfontein and Tembisa.

Kimberley metropolitan area. - The urban areas of Kimberley, Homestead, Kenilworth and Ronald's Vlei.

Odendaalsrus - Allanridge metropolitan area. - All urban areas in the magisterial district of Odendaalsrus.

Pietermaritzburg metropolitan area. - The following areas in the magisterial district of Pietermaritzburg: Pietermaritzburg, Hilton Road, Lincoln Mead, Sweetwaters, Winterskloof, Cleland, Dunverla, Edendale, Hollingwood, Ockertskraal.

Port Elizabeth metropolitan area. - The municipal area of Port Elizabeth and the adjoining urban areas of Walmer and Bethelsdorp.

Pretoria metropolitan area. - All urban areas in the magisterial district of Pretoria, except Clayville and Irene.

Springs metropolitan area. - The whole of the magisterial district of Springs.

Virginia metropolitan area. - All urban areas in the magisterial district of Virginia.

Welkom metropolitan area. - All urban areas in the magisterial district of Welkom.

6. VARIATIONS IN DATA

In some cases there are differences between the figures for corresponding items in different tables. These variations may be ascribed to the method adopted in machine processing the data. In most cases the differences are relatively slight and therefore unimportant. The "differences" are indicated by a plus (+) sign or minus (-) sign below the total at the end of each table concerned. This difference added to or subtracted from the total of the tabulated figures gives the actual total.
