Robert an RAF pilot from Cambridge recently told "IN News" about his experiences in the Second World War.

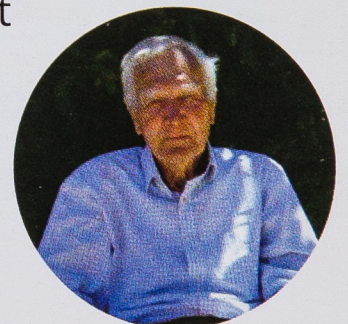
War is truly dreadful. That's why the founders of the European Union came together to bring peace to our
