Report of Conference.

Dec. 10th 1907

In accordance with a Resolution of the Executive Committee that Representatives of the Local Committees shd be invited to meet in the Ex. Committee a conference was held in the offices of the Society on Dec. 10th. Six members of the Ex. Comm. were present & 22 representatives from the Constituencies. The chair was taken by Mrs Fawcett. After full discussion

the following Resolution, moved by Mrs Harrington of North St. Pancras & seconded by Mrs Bradley Reid was carried unanimously.

"That a conference should be called at least 4 times a year of a representative appointed by each Local Committee & Branch Society & of the Local Hon. Secs of constituencies where there is no Committee, to meet the Executive Committee."

Further it was proposed Miss Dimock, Seconded Mrs Penn Gaskell ^{of Willerden} & carried:

"That Miss Milford be invited to assist Miss Strachey with the Secretarial work of the Conference."
