WOMEN OF BRITAIN! 1	DO YOU KNOW THAT:
MEN never lose their BRITISH NATIONALITY unless they deliberately renounce it.	WOMEN without their consent lose their NATIONALITY an become ALIENS if they marry a foreigner.
MEN have fuller opportunities for EDUCATION, PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL TRAINING.	WOMEN have fewer scholarships, fewer places in UNIVERSITIES many MEDICAL AND DENTAL SCHOOLS are CLOSED t them.
MEN ALONE may be admitted to Holy Orders in the ESTABLISHED CHURCH.	WOMEN are denied this full SPIRITUAL VOCATION.
MEN carry out the FOREIGN POLICY of our country as decided by Parliament through the DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR SERVICE.	WOMEN may not even enter the DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR SERVICE.
MEN are responsible for all the real direction of our COLONIAL EMPIRE.	WOMEN have not yet been given any high administrative post in th COLONIAL SERVICE.
MEN in the CIVIL SERVICE get better salaries, promotion and the higher posts.	WOMEN get lower pay and are seldom chosen for the higher posts.  They must resign on MARRIAGE: this applies to the majority

They must resign on MARRIAGE; this applies to the majority of TEACHERS and in practice to all LOCAL GOVERNMENT POSTS.

WOMEN are debarred from some TRADES AND PROCESSES and usually get lower pay.

WOMEN'S WORK is ALL THE REST.

WOMEN if they be housewives get NOTHING in their own right. The BEVERIDGE PLAN would give equal benefits to single women, but married women earners would get a lower benefit and the HOUSEWIFE would get NOTHING in her own right but a little through her husband.

WOMEN are penalised and tried for actions condoned in men.

## JUSTICE FOR WOMEN MEANS:

- AMEND THE NATIONALITY LAW according to our Government policy declared at Geneva in 1931: The British Government considers that it is right that all disabilities of married women in matters of nationality should be removed and that, so far as nationality is concerned, a married woman should be in the same position as a man, married or unmarried, or a single woman.
- EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES for GIRLS AND BOYS in Schools, Universities and Technical Colleges. The opening to them of all Medical and Dental Schools. All State scholarships to be awarded on merit regardless of sex.
- ADMISSION OF QUALIFIED WOMEN to all Orders of the ESTABLISHED CHURCH.
- OPENING TO WOMEN OF THE FOREIGN SERVICE, Diplomatic, Consular and Trade Services, with equal training, opportunity and promotion with men.
- EMPLOYMENT OF WOMEN on equal terms with men in the COLONIAL SERVICE with proper consideration of the needs of women of native races under our control.
- REAL EQUALITY OF OPPORTUNITY for men and women in the CIVIL SERVICE and LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE; and no MARRIAGE BAR.
- THE OPENING TO WOMEN of all TRADES AND PROCESSES in INDUSTRY; a STANDARD RATE FOR THE JOB for every competent man and woman, married or unmarried.
- GIVE WOMEN IN THE HOME opportunity for economic independance, and participation in the social and intellectual life of the community and time for recreation.
- EQUALITY OF ECONOMIC SECURITY. Under Beveridge or any other Insurance Plan, this can only be achieved by every citizen contributing to a NATIONAL INSURANCE SCHEME whereby all may be sure of receiving treatment in sickness, an adequate living allowance in unemployment, disability and old age.
- A HIGHER AND EQUAL MORAL STANDARD for both sexes.
- Let us have Democracy! Let us have Justice: The only basis for the better world of to-morrow and of true comradeship between men and women.
