I am not quite sure about  
the last £10, whether it should  
be £10 or £20. I gave you  
so far as I collected £10 note

to change at Charing  
Cross before we set out  
I think another £20  
note somewhere abroad  
but you will have used  
as if Dr Brachet's account  
was only 50 francs, it  
would seem rather out  
of proportion to have him  
a gratuity of ~~three~~ more  
than double that amount.  
I should not feel slighted  
by asking Vagt what he  
£20 after consulting with  
those out of whose pockets  
the money will come.

We were quite right in not  
having an apparently excessive  
charge until we had done  
this. I shall be glad to hear  
that you have got the  
dark safe with its contents  
jewellery &c & hope you  
know the Locksmith to  
be honest - I should have  
been afraid to allow it

can give it to any lawyer you
