Everything is going on
all right here I think. The baby's
vaccination has taken strongly but
he is behaving like an angel as
usual - Maggie is getting on all
right except that she is extremely
nervous and jumpy - it gives her
fits ~~to~~ ^{to see} Dicky walking across the room
for fear of his falling down &
injuring himself for life &c and
I think the best thing will be to
remove her entirely from the sphere
of the infants until she has some-

what recovered her nerves. Of course if this is done the babe will have to be weaned - I have spoken to the doctor on the subject and he says that although he is in favour of non weaning ~~the~~ as a rule it must of course be done if necessary for the mother's health and if I wish he will put it in hand - Nurse Turner is strongly in favour of M's being removed and so am I, so the following has been decided on.

Weaning is put in hand on recovery of babe from vaccination viz Friday and the party will ~~then~~ on completion of W's proceed to London - probable date 5th Dec^r

board, burn and engage the rooms then from 5th Dec^r, beating down if poss. to 6 guas. The 2 nurses & 2 babes will go there & he & I will go direct to Brighton or somewhere for a fortnight, leaving the entry into ~~the~~ the lodgings to be done by the nurses - I think the coping with housekeeping will be too much for M so have decided on the boarding house after all & hope it has not been snapped up already - If for the time the nurses only will be in residence further reduction can be made so much the better - This letter is written in a fiendish hurry to catch the post so is probably incoherent, but if further explanation will be

sent if required; the main object
is to secure the rooms.
