as usual.

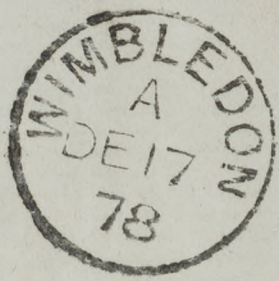
I am sure, the family
