To act at the end " & further resolves to place on record its appreciation of the efforts being made by the Conciliation Committee & its Secretary, Mr. Brailsford, to carry the Bill

Resolution B Moved by Manchester -
Amendment moved by London

To omit all words after 'that' & substitute the following
'as the pronouncement of the Prime Minister in regard to
the Representation of the People Act 1910 does not exclude
the possibility of the passing of the Bill, the course of events
be carefully watched & a Special Council Meeting be called
to decide upon vigorous action should the Bill be dropped
after the second reading; & that meanwhile further
demonstrations of the growing strength of the movement be
organised without delay, & every possible effort be made
to secure an overwhelming majority in favour of the
Bill on its second reading.'

Resolution I Moved by Manchester.

Amendments moved London

1. For "instruction" to substitute "recommendation"
2. After the word "organise" to insert "in co-operation with the local society."
3. After the word "London" to insert "& in other parts of the country."
4. For "and" after the word "Council" to substitute "or"
5. ~~And the words~~ "people of the metropolis" to substitute "public."

The resolution will then read as follows: -

That it be a recommendation to the Executive Committee to organise public meetings in co-operation with the local societies in London & in other parts of the country on the occasion of the ^{Meeting of the} Annual Council or on any other occasion where it may appear desirable that the policy or conduct of the Union should be elucidated or pressed upon the attention of Parliament & the public.
