the local Committee "pocket"

money." I am sorry to hurry you
in replying, but I am sure to be
asked at the Committee meeting
on Friday. The Ealing Women's
Association (a literary Society) is
willing to arrange a meeting for
us upon December 11th, if we will
provide a speaker. I am at en-
-closing the receipt for my cheque,
also a postal order for 5/-, being
a subscription from Mrs. Bathe,
7abo, Maryat Road, Wimbledon,
would you kindly send her an
official receipt. She is a buying
person, she was going to join our

local Committee, but has now written
to say that she would rather not do
so as her sympathies are with the
W. S. & P. U., but will join our Committee
for a year if we wish, altho she would
much rather not. Any way she is
subscribing to ~~the~~ us, so as regards
her sympathies I think she must
mean that she approves of opposing
members of the government. I am
arranging for several small
Drawing Room meetings here, if
you sent me some cards I would
fill them up & send them to you
as I suggested. On Wednesday,
Oct. 30th, there was a meeting

at Mr: Morris's, Oakfield, Combe
Wood, Kingston, at which Mrs
Emily Davis spoke.

Monday, November 4th, meeting
at Mr: Christie's, Herleigh, Kingston
Hill, at which I spoke.

I have arranged for three more
down here before Christmas, &
Mr: Fawcett is speaking on
"Women as Citizens", next Monday
at the Congregational Church
Union in Kingston, but I suppose
we can't claim that so we have
not arranged the meeting. I rang
you up on the telephone yesterday
but was sorry you were not in, took

at Reyate, as I had received a
postcard from Mrs Pym saying

enclosing the card for you to
