Dear Miss Phillips,

I am desired by the Executive Committee of the London Society to inform you that they will arrange for the collection of signatures to voters' petitioners in as many as possible of the 58 constituencies of the County of London. They cannot undertake to send in petitions from every constituency but they are making every endeavour to obtain as many signatures as possible in London. They will be responsible also for the organisation of petitions in the following extra metropolitan constituencies in which there are branches of the London Society:-

Berks, Windsor, Middlesex, Ealing, Harrow & Hornsey
Surrey, Epsom, Kingston and Wimbledon.

They fear that their Hon. Secretary at Weybridge may not be able to do very much to collect signatures in the Chertsey Division of Surrey, but she is actively questioning the candidates.

The Committee cannot at present say whether they will be able to arrange for petitions in the 2 constituencies of West Ham.
