d. at her home in someone on Lake Garda -

1884 b. Ripon, d. of Nina Ellington Collinson (novelist Nina Abbott)

She abandoned teaching to become sec. manager of a noted
music-hall artist ^(Marguerite Broadfoot) - rec'd into R.C. Church - took part in
Women's suffrage movement + during 1914-18 served in
Women's Legion

1920 - went on stage for 9 years. (ret'd. to it at intervals during
war 1939-45)

became a strong supporter of Labour

1930 - From 1930 onwards lived mostly in Italy on shores of L. Garda
where for the most part she continued to live afterwards.
