GERMANY'S STARVING BABIES.

RUBBER TEATS REPORT.

ON December 27, 1918, a dispatch from Mr. H. W. Nevinson, in Cologne, appeared in the *Daily News*, in which he said: "I will only add that the physician's last word to me was an entreaty to England to send out a million or two india-rubber teats, because Germany has no rubber. A rubber teat which used to cost 1½d. now costs from 4s. to 5s., and the babies cannot get up the milk by sucking the bone teats which have to serve as substitutes."

We, the Women's International League, felt that this afforded an opportunity of giving a practical demonstration of international goodwill and friendship, and of contributing real assistance to the German women and children in helping to save the lives of the babies; so we undertook to send out a million rubber teats for feeding bottles to Germany if the necessary facilities could be obtained. After encountering considerable difficulties with various Government Departments, we ultimately obtained permission to send out some cases of teats through the British Red Cross, if they would undertake the transport. The Red Cross willingly agreed to this, and were exceedingly helpful in every way. They arranged to send out the whole consignment of teats to Berlin, where General Sir Richard Ewart, their representative, kindly undertook to receive them and hand them over to Dr. Elizabeth Rotten for distribution. Dr. Rotten made herself responsible for the whole of the distribution, in both the occupied and unoccupied areas of Germany.

While these arrangements were going forward England was being ransacked for rubber teats suitable for German bottles, which are of an entirely different shape from the ordinary English feeding bottle, and therefore need a specially shaped teat. Investigation soon proved that there were nothing like a million teats of the right kind in the British Isles. All that could be found were immediately bought through Messrs. Schaefer, to whom our thanks are due for

all the trouble they took in procuring and arranging for packing the teats, and for placing the orders necessary for the manufacture of hundreds of thousands of additional teats with the greatest possible dispatch.

Meanwhile, we were incurring a very heavy financial responsibility, since, realizing the urgency of the need for the teats, and the inevitable delay, in any case, before they could actually reach the German babies, we felt it imperative to proceed with the arrangements immediately, without waiting for the very considerable sum of £6,200 necessary for the purchase and packing of the teats. The result was that no definite appeal was made to the public to raise a fund until after the order for the whole consignment of teats had actually been given. It was felt, however, that once the public was appealed to for such a cause there could be no doubt but that they would gladly respond and contribute the money; this proved to be the case, as the accompanying balance sheet shows. The *Daily News*, the *Manchester Guardian*, the *Herald*, and the *Nation* all printed paragraphs or letters of appeal for the fund, and contributions poured in from every side, many of them enclosed in the most touching letters. Letters and money came from soldiers, from mothers of soldiers, from interned prisoners of war, from mothers of men who had been interned in Germany, from children, from the aged, and, indeed, from men, women, and children of every class and kind, all anxious to do what they could to save the starving German babies, "because," as one woman expressed it, "they belong to everybody: children are international."

We hear from Dr. Rotten that the distribution of the teats has been undertaken by the German Welfare Committee, with which she works in Berlin, and they are arranging for the teats to be distributed right through Germany. She says, in a letter written on March 20: "The numbers sent to each district allow of distribution to every baby up to six months in the centres of child welfare, and possibly up to eight or nine months. Each principal centre in a State or Province is undertaking the division and distribution among the less important centres, informing me of the places, numbers, and circumstances of distribution, and so on, taking great care to avoid overlapping (German Austria to be included, if they have not received any direct supply by other means)."

It is impossible to exaggerate the profound depth of feeling that has been aroused in the German women by this token of goodwill and friendship from their English sisters. In another letter Dr. Rotten says: "The undertaking of the English branch of the Women's International League for Permanent Peace, to send a

sign of goodwill and conciliation to the German women by providing their babies with rubber teats, was a double joy to us, because practical help served as a living proof of how warmly hearts can beat for sufferers in other lands, even in countries which have been separated for years by a national feud." She goes on to say that a copy of a leaflet issued by the German Welfare Organization is sent to all the recipients of teats. The following is the text of the leaflet:—

GERMAN WELFARE ORGANIZATION.

English Help for German Infants.

Since the first days of the War in 1914—how few know of it!—in the midst of the destruction, innumerable fine threads spun by active human love have been stretching silently and beneficently from land to land. In London the English Society of Friends founded in August 1914 a great relief work for all Germans, Austrians, and Hungarians who had fallen into distress by tens of thousands; numberless repatriated or interned men and their families can tell of the loving help which did much to dispel the bitterness of their lot, of the camp workshops, the playgrounds, and garden plots, in which the prisoners were led from aimless discontent to profitable occupation. In Germany a relief organization gave loving help to the foreigners and helped them to reach their homes or to feel themselves protected in the enemy's land. In the spring of 1915 women from Belgium, Germany, England, and France, and other lands, met in Holland and pledged themselves to serve the cause of reconciliation by counteracting hatred and national feud. In all countries "Women's Leagues for Permanent Peace" have endeavoured, even during the War, to lessen bitterness and to change enmity into understanding. Since the Armistice this circle of Englishwomen has exerted itself to give the Germans a token of friendship and sympathy. They heard that in Germany many mothers could not satisfy their little ones, and that there were no good teats; so they hastened to send, as a first consignment, 500,000 rubber teats to Germany as a present, each one a symbol of the wish of these Englishwomen to lessen the sorrow and need of their German sisters.

Helping hands are stretching out to one another. Only a tiny beginning, a faint far-off voice, and it will be a long time before it becomes a loud call. But yet a ray of sunshine in whose pitying goodness the nearly dried-up twig may flower once more. Let it in, that the healing powers may increase.

We of the Women's International League, in common, we hope, with all who have given to this fund, feel the joy of being privileged to do something, however small, not merely to alleviate suffering and contribute towards the health and happiness of the next generation, but also to heal the wounds and cure the bitterness that four years of bloodshed and misery must have left in the hearts of our German sisters.
