Order: Employment of Women (Amendment)

Order no. 6991/1933 of the Minister of Commerce, to amend certain provisions of Order no. 155,102/1930¹ of the Minister of Commerce respecting restrictions on the employment of women in hotels (boarding-houses), restaurants, cafés, coffee bars, dairies, public-houses and pastrycooks' shops. Dated 8th February, 1933.

In pursuance of the authorisation contained in sections 57, no. (6), and 58 of Act no. XII of 1922², I hereby issue the following Order in agreement with the Minister of the Interior to amend certain provisions of Order no. 155,102/1930¹ of the Minister of Commerce respecting restrictions on the employment of women in hotels (boarding-houses), restaurants, cafés, coffee bars, dairies, public-houses and pastrycooks' shops.

1. The following provisions shall be substituted for the provisions laid down in the first paragraph of section 2 of Order no. 155,102/1930¹:—

"It shall not be lawful to employ women who have not attained the age of twenty years to wait on customers or to act as clerks in hotels, cafés, coffee bars, dairies and pastrycooks' shops. Women who have not attained the age of twenty-four years shall not be employed in the above-mentioned occupations in public-houses."

This Order shall come into operation eight days after its promulgation.
