Dear Madam,

I am instructed by the Executive Committee of the National Union of Women's Suffrage Societies to remind you that the next Congress of the International Woman Suffrage Alliance will meet in Stockholm June 11 - 18, 1911, and that the twelve delegates of the N.U.W.S.S. to the Congress will have to be elected at the January Council. Nominations of representatives for election to the delegation will be received from the societies of the Union until Dec. 30th.
