I was so glad to have a sight of you today. This may be the last letter I get this for a time. But the children & I will keep the flag flying, actively waving. I shall try to be in court tomorrow, if possible but I am very busy, & must get back tomorrow. I gave your message in court & said I could do nothing. A case like Kodds has been tried to dismiss for not attending Church. &c. The dismissal has been quashed & the teacher wins. Another case of a married teacher has been won & she reinstated. Children very well & bright. I was asked to speak again at Nottingham tonight for the funeral, but am here.
