The weather. Why we didn't take Lytton &
James into the house I can't think! -
At least they'd have had chairs, instead
of a log. But they look surprisingly
cheerful. I've had a most
curious disappointment in looking for
negatives. In one year, 1913, I took
7 photographs of Lytton, more than
at any other time. All but two of
the negatives have disappeared & as
far as I can see they are the only
ones of all the hundreds I have developed
arent there - (but it odd? I keep
them all put away in a drawer
& among me, but myself would have
great difficulty in finding any special
ones. However I have the positives
so I always could see the negatives
made & wish if it seems worth
while. You must see them when
you come back. I wish I had
more. But some of these are good
