Froben Henni Forchhammer

Danish Founder. Danish National Council  
1899 of Women. Internationalist

1915. Organized procession of 20,000  
Women in White to celebrate grant  
to Danish women of right to vote.

1916. "Ford" Peace Conference. F. Forchhammer  
introduced the idea of continuous  
mediation for peace. something  
permanent.

1914 - 20 Organized clearing house for personal  
<sup>family</sup> information between war-scattered or  
divided families & friends.

1920. League of Nations First Assembly  
preceded by Great Conference  
called by International Council  
of Women at Copenhagen which  
passed resolutions asking govern-

ments to send some women delegates  
to the League Assembly in November  
of same year.

Fru Bonnevie, Norway

First woman to address this "Parliament of the World" was Froken Forchhammer. Her speech was an appeal for the women & children in Turkey & Asia Minor taken into captivity forcibly during the war.

Lectured throughout on Peace & its support by women. Acted as leader & guide to women later delegates or ~~as~~ attending as volunteers or society representatives at later L. of N. assemblies.
