## CANADA 8 NOVA SCOTIA

Act: Minimum Wage (Women)

An Act to amend Chapter 11 of the Acts of 1920, "The Minimum Wage for Women Act, 19201". 21 Geo. 5, c. 57. Passed 24th March, 1931.

- I. Section 8 of Chapter II of the Acts of 1920, "The Minimum Wage for Women Act, 19201", is amended by adding thereto the following subsection:
- "(2) Every employer, whenever so required from time to time by the Board, shall furnish to the Board a statement containing the names, ages and addresses, and the actual earnings of all of his employees while employed by him during the year previous to the date of such statement, together with the average hours per week worked by each employee, and such further and other information as may be required by the Board, and such statement shall be verified by statutory declaration."
- 2. Section II of said Chapter II, as that section is amended by Chapter 57 of the Acts of 1924<sup>2</sup>, is amended by adding thereto the following subsection:
- "(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of the next preceding subsection, any employee, who is employed at less than the minimum wage to which she is entitled, may sue and recover as for a debt in any court of competent jurisdiction the difference between the wages she has been paid during the year next preceding the date of commencement of such proceedings and the wages to which she is entitled."
- 3. Said Chapter II is amended by adding thereto the following section:
- "16. All orders made by the Board shall be published in two successive issues of the *Royal Gazette* and the same shall come into force and effect on a date named therein, which date shall be subsequent to the second publication thereof."


