Dear Madam,

In connection with a request received from Mrs. Ramsay MacDonald for the loan of the emblems used in the demonstration of April 27th., I am instructed to inform you that the Executive Committee of the London Society for Women's Suffrage will have much pleasure in lending these emblems to the Women's Trade Union League, to be used by them in a pageant in the Earl's Court Exhibition on Saturday July 17th, on the following conditions:

1. That all arrangements and expenses connected with the carriage of the emblems between 58 Victoria Street and the Earl's Court Exhibition, shall be undertaken by the Women's Trade Union League.

2. That any damage to the emblems shall be made good by the Women's Trade Union League.

3. That the following statement shall appear upon notices of the pageant: Emblems designed and made by the

I write to inform you that, upon your representation that several of the organisations taking part in the Labour Fete on July 17th., were in no way connected with any political party, your application for the loan of the emblems used in the demonstration of April 27th., has been reconsidered by my Committee.

I am desired to inform you that my Committee will be very happy to lend these emblems to the Women's Trade Union League, to be used by them in a pageant in the Earl's Court Exhibition, on Saturday July 19th. on the following conditions:
