My Lord,

I wrote the enclosed letter to you dated 29.3.1912., but did not post it, as, after writing it, I received a satisfactory reply from the Governor of Holloway Gaol, that each of the 3 prisoners were alike sentenced to 3 months, and would, if their conduct were good, be released on June 14th, otherwise on June 18th next.

May I however thank your Lordship for the fact that the letter from the Chairman of the Newington Sessions appears at last to have induced the Home Secretary to grant to the Suffragette prisoners the facilities to which




they were entitled under the old rule as  
political prisoners, and to release Nurse  
Pitfield.

My Lord,

I was present yesterday afternoon in your Court at the Newington Sessions, when my wife Nellie Taylor was, jointly with Nellie Crocker and Eliza Roberts, charged, and convicted before, and sentenced by Judge Lawrie for breaking three windows of the Sloan St. Post Office on March 4th.

I see by the report in today's London "Times" and "Daily Mail" that the first two prisoners are reported as sentenced to 3 months, and the last prisoner to 3 months, imprisonment. As all three prisoners appeared under exactly the same circumstances, and as I understood



that the sentence was in each case reduced, (founder  
on the application of the last prisoner, to  
3 months, I should be much obliged if Your  
Lordship would assure me, in enclosed  
stamped envelope, that each of the three  
prisoners has only been sentenced to three  
months.
