we advocate Trade Union
principles, - as the contrary,
on our platform, as it is a
question entirely outside

the purpose for which the
National Union exists. We
do refer to the use which have
made of Trade Unions,
but merely as a matter
of historical illustration
of an argument.

In regard to the practical
questions we are naturally
ever advocates of fair
wages, and as an actual
fact, we enquire into
any case where there is

a suspicion of unfair
dealing and should introduce
an action for any firm
against whom it was
proved.
