the contrast with the miserable performance of Cambridge in 1920 &
1921 is very bitter - but it is some consolation to know that the votes
given in 1921, if enforced to resident members of the university would
have shown a majority for the inclusion of women. I am all in favour
of proceeding by way of an appeal to Parliament, as soon as the
Report of the University Commission has been presented. Your charming
book might greatly help the latter stages of our fight on Cambridge.
