with an underlying dash of humor & sympathy. She can really

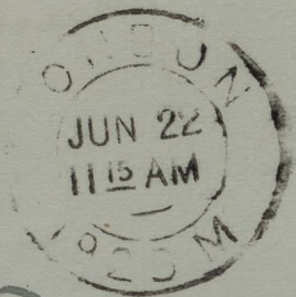
walk very well now & goes on foot accompanied, & her
