Dear Madam,

As an instruction from the Annual Council Meeting may I ask you to send in by return the names and addresses of Secretaries of any branch Society or local Committee of your Society that we may include them in our Annual Report.

2. At the last Committee Meeting it was decided that a weekly report of its work should be sent out by the National Union. This report would be sent gratis by the Union to the Secretaries of Societies. Will you let me know at once what number you would like to have? The expense to the Union will be very heavy and we hope you will only ask for a number of which you are certain to dispose. Will you kindly send us news, reports of meetings and forthcoming events for inclusion in the Report.

3. The recommendation of the Secretaries' Meeting to have a self-denial week simultaneously all over Great Britain, of which the local Societies might retain half the proceeds, was cordially approved by the Executive Committee and the date was fixed for May 9th.-16th.
