Court he said he did not see me

If I had been above the Duke Shore  
I have given the witness box against  
him. My 3 months dates from March  
1946. If I get 1/6 off - I shall be out about

the big things which we all share  
in common. I heard through Mr.  
Hankerson that the dear children
