PREFACE

The object of this Handbook is to assist girls and women to obtain suitable hostel accommodation in London, and the list, with a few exceptions, is restricted to those hostels which charge two guineas a week or less.

It is published by the Central Council for the Social Welfare of Girls and Women in London, who feel keenly that it is of great importance to ensure that girls while in London can live in healthy surroundings, the term healthy being interpreted as including not only sanitation, but also a healthy social atmosphere. It is from this point of view that they have undertaken the preparation of this list.

It is not claimed that the list is in any way complete, and it is hoped that those interested in the welfare of girls in the Metropolitan area will forward criticisms and suggestions so that future editions of the work may possess added usefulness.

In publishing the eighth edition of this book the Central Council desire to thank all those who have assisted in its preparation, particularly the officers of the London County Council to whom they are greatly indebted for their courtesy and helpful advice.

NOTES

The type of accommodation given in the Hostels varies considerably and it will be well to notice the following explanation:—

“CUBICLES” are rooms divided by curtains or board partitions, not reaching to the ceiling.

“SHARED ROOMS” are those where two, three or more beds are arranged according to the size and price of the room.

“PARTIAL BOARD” means breakfast, dinner or hot supper in the evening on week days, and all meals on Sundays.

Accommodation in a Hostel or Club should always if possible be booked beforehand. Applications should be addressed to the Warden of the Hostel or Club.
