Decree: Employment of Women and Young Persons (Tobacco Industry)

Διάταγμα τῆς 18 Δεκεμβρίου 1926 περὶ τῆς ἐργασίας τῶν γυναικῶν καὶ ἀνηλίκων ἐν τῇ ἐπεξεργασίᾳ τοῦ καπνοῦ. (Ἐφημερὶς τῆς Κυβερνήσεως, 1926, τεύχος πρῶτον, ἀρ. 437, σ. 3445.)

Decree respecting the employment of women and young persons in the working up of tobacco. Dated 18th December, 1926.

On the recommendation of Our Minister of National Economy, We hereby approve and issue the following Decree in pursuance of section 17 of Act *no. 4029*¹ concerning the employment of women and young persons.

SOLE SECTION. Male young persons who have not attained the age of fourteen years and female young persons who have not attained the age of sixteen years shall not be employed in the working up of tobacco. This prohibition shall apply to the work of opening bales, sorting leaves, fermentation and stripping of the fermented heaps, drying in closed rooms, and also to the work in the tobacco industry of cutting and packing tobacco and making cigarettes.

No. (3) of section 37 of the Legislative Decree of 14th August, 1913², respecting the administration of Act *no. 4029*¹ concerning the employment of women and young persons in factories, workshops, etc., shall be repealed.

Our Minister of National Economy shall be responsible for the promulgation and administration of this Decree.
