The following Order is issued by the Governing Commission under Article 19 of the Annex to Section IV of Part III of the Peace Treaty of Versailles, under sections 120e and 139a of the Industrial Code,<sup>1</sup> and in conformity with its decision of 31st March, 1925.

I. In amendment of the [German] Notification of 20th May, 1912, respecting the employment of women and young persons in rolling and forging works (Reichsgesetzblatt, p. 311)<sup>2</sup>, and the Order of 18th July, 1923, respecting the same subject (Amtsblatt, p. 169)<sup>3</sup>, the period of validity of the provisions of the said Notification and Order shall be extended to 1st April, 1926.

2. The Order of 18th July, 1923, concerning the regulation of the hours of work and breaks of women and young persons employed in industrial undertakings (Amtsblatt, p. 169)<sup>4</sup>, shall apply to the duration of the breaks.

The following Order is issued by the Governing Commission under Article 19 of the Annex to Section IV of Part III of the Peace Treaty of Versailles, under sections 120e and 139a of the Industrial Code<sup>1</sup>, and in conformity with its decision of 31st March, 1925.
