You may have  
3 nice rooms at Fel. v. Wasmuth,  
2 rather big and a smaller one,  
all next to each other. I did  
accordingly take them during  
from the 25<sup>th</sup>, unless you send  
me word, that you shall start later.  
The terms are for the two bigger  
rooms 2 M. 60¢ per day, and  
1 M. for the smaller one. Break-  
fast 60¢ for each, exclusive

of eggs and meat, which have  
to be paid extra. Dinner is at  
1 lb. 50 and supper at 1 lb. in  
pouffe, but you need not take  
your meals there. The cookery is  
however very nice, as Fat. v. Munn  
does it herself, and everything is  
very clean. You will have to  
tell her every morning whether  
you want to dine at home or  
shall be away — the same for  
the evening. Fire is to be paid

when at 30 s. for each room,  
and I think I shall certainly  
order it for the day of your  
arrival, unless the weather  
turns quite warm, which is  
hardly to be expected.

You would much oblige me  
by bringing a small box  
of Lady-peas for me (fine  
points) that I cannot get here,  
but if it is any trouble to  
get them, don't.
