friend to call.

I have so far received one
letter from you. I should
buy much like some
papers. We simply do not
know what to go on.
A woman died last night
in the ward.

Please send me some writing
paper & envelopes
Give my love to the dear
children. I am sure they are
having a grand time. I look
very funny in workhouse
clothes. I wonder what you
would say if you saw
me!
