## INCANDESCENT MANTLES TRADE

THIS REPORT on the Incandescent Mantles Trade relates to establishments engaged wholly or mainly in the manufacture of incandescent mantles.

This trade is one of the miscellaneous manufacturing industries included in minimum list heading 199(3) in the Standard Industrial Classification.

Any establishments in Northern Ireland are excluded in 1948; no production was recorded there in this trade for 1937 or 1935.
