

#### CAMPS IN USE FOR HOUSING PURPOSES

As at 31st December, 1965 there were 694 families occupying 50 former camps administered by local authorities under the Housing Acts.

## UNFIT HOUSES IN TEMPORARY USE FOR HOUSING Housing Act, 1957

On the 30th September, 1965, there were 34,083 unfit houses retained for temporary accommodation under Sections 48, 17(2), and 46 of the Act. In addition, 19 unfit houses were licensed for temporary occupation under Sections 34 or 53 of the Act.

#### HOUSING LABOUR FORCE

The number of operatives aged 15 and over employed by building and civil engineering contractors on the construction of new permanent houses and the preparation of housing sites was provisionally estimated at

283,000 (30.4.65) 276,000 (31.7.65) 279,000 (31.10.65)

These figures do not include building and civil engineering workers directly employed by local authorities. In December, 1965, the number of such workers was 14,373.

The number of operatives engaged on the repair and maintenance of houses (including conversions, extensions and alterations) was provisionally estimated at 147,000 in October, 1965.







#### NOTES

- 1. "Houses". This term includes flats and other permanent dwellings of every kind and war-destroyed houses rebuilt but excludes all temporary houses.
- 2. Areas. Houses provided by a local authority are shown in table I against the name of that authority, whether they are erected inside or outside their own area. A table showing the adjustments to be made to obtain figures of houses erected in each area was included in the appendix to the Return for 30th September, 1965. (This table will normally be published in June of each year.) Houses provided for private owners are shown in table I against the name of the authority in whose area the houses are situated.
- 3. New towns. Houses built for private owners in new towns on sites in which the Commission or development corporations have an interest are included in columns 4 and 5 against the name of the local authority or authorities in whose area the new town is situated. The numbers of such houses under construction or completed are also shown separately, in italics, against the name of each new town. Houses built by the Commission or development corporations are shown in columns 1–3 against the name of each new town and do not appear elsewhere.
- 4. Boundary changes. Where the boundaries of local authority areas have been altered, houses are shown against the local authority in whose area they are now situated. Following the alteration of certain local authority boundaries on 1st April, 1965 amendments were made to the figures shown in the Appendix for March, 1965. Table III gives details of adjustments to the figures of houses completed up to 31st March 1965 in the local authority areas concerned.
- 5. Housing associations. Local authorities in whose area houses have been provided by housing associations (shown in table II) are indicated by an obelisk in table I. In appendices issued before June 1962 the figures were combined in table I.
- 6. **Population.** Column 7 of table I shows the estimate of the home population prepared by the Registrar General.
- 7. Clearance areas. Column 8 of table I shows the number of houses in clearance orders and compulsory purchase orders made under part III of the Housing Act 1957 confirmed by the Minister since 1st January, 1955. Column 9 shows the number of houses demolished under part III of the Housing Act 1957.
- 8. Demolition and closing orders, etc. Column 10 of table I shows the number of unfit houses demolished or closed elsewhere than in clearance areas.
