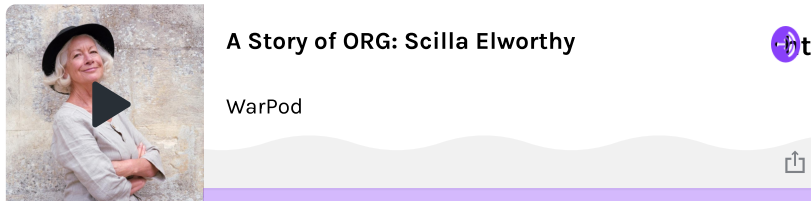


A Story of ORG: Scilla Elworthy
