Part X.—Live Stock.

376 For the record of the Live Stock in the Colony, provision was made on the Householder's Schedules, and from the Returns sent in, the following results were obtained:—

377. This Table gives a record of the Live Stock in possession or charge of Europeans or Whites, on the Census day, throughout the Colony, information for each Magisterial Division or Census Area, and for the Colony as a whole, being shown separately. Table I.
See Annexures.

378. Table II. furnishes a record of the same information for Indians and Asiatics, Table III. for Mixed Races and Others, and Table IV. for Natives. Tables II., III., IV.
See Annexures.

379. As we were unable to approach Natives on this subject owing to the restrictions placed upon our Enumerators by the Government, information concerning their Live Stock was supplied approximately by the Magistrates, who received valuable assistance from the various Stock Inspectors in the respective Districts.

380. Is a General Summary of the information for the entire Live Stock Returns for the whole Colony, whilst Table VI. is a comparative Table, shewing the difference between figures for 1904, and those published in the Statistical Year Book for 1903. Tables V., VI.
See Annexures.

381. From the foregoing Tables it will be seen that there is a general increase all round. Glancing at the various figures, under the different sub-heads, which in the aggregate give the total number of Horned Cattle, showing an increase of 40,176, we observe that there is a considerable decrease in the number of Milch Cows. This may be largely accounted for by the fact that during the years previous to the Census taking, *i.e.*, 1902 and 1903, a great number of Cows were kept solely for the use of Military Hospitals and other Centres, which with the termination of the war, and subsequent removal of Troops, were either slaughtered or removed from the Colony.

388. Is a comparative Summary, shewing for the Colony and its sections, the number of each kind of Live Stock, according to the Census of 1904, compared with the Statistical Year Book for 1903, detailing the increase of each kind. Table VIII. See Annexures.

389. Of the Stock in possession of "Europeans or Whites," with which we have embodied all Stock in possession of "Mixed and Other Races," this having been done in the Statistical Year Book, we note an increase all round; the greatest increase being in the number of Cattle, viz., 60,060. Of the Stock in possession of "Indians and Asiatics," we also note a general increase, in this case, the greatest increase being with Goats, numbering 10,718.

390. Figures relating to Stock in possession of Natives are, at the best, only approximate, and must be considered accordingly. Comparing our Returns with those of the Year Book, there is an apparent decrease in the number of Cattle, Horses, and Woolled Sheep; whilst, on the contrary, there is an increase in the number of "Other Sheep," "Other Goats," "Pigs," and "Poultry."

391. Gives at a glance the proportional increase per cent. of the Stock in possession of the various "Races." For Stock in possession of "Europeans or Whites," the greatest proportional increase on the numbers given for 1903 is with "Pigs," viz., 107.73 per cent. "Cattle" show an increase of 23.31 per cent., "Horses," 48.88 per cent.; "Mules and Asses," 95.60 per cent.; "Woolled Sheep," 0.04 per cent.; "Other Sheep," 81.44 per cent.; "Angora Goats," 40.99 per cent.; "Other Goats," 70.40 per cent.; and "Poultry," 91.91 per cent. Table IX. See Annexures.

392. For Stock in possession of "Indians and Asiatics," "Other Sheep" show the greatest proportional increase, with 3,292.86 per cent. "Cattle" show 73.96 per cent.; "Horses," 90.55 per cent.; "Other Goats," 80.89 per cent.; and "Poultry," 317.67 per cent.

393. For Stock in possession of Natives, after "Poultry," "Pigs" head the list of increases with 36.41 per cent.; "Other Goats" 30.59 per cent.; and "Other Sheep," 25.94 per cent.

Part XI.—Buildings and Dwellings.

394. The instructions given on the Householders' Schedules for the assistance of persons recording information as to the nature of their places of habitation were as follows :—

"State whether the outer walls are built of Stone, Brick, Wood, Concrete, Iron, Canvas, or what other materials. Also state number of Rooms, including Kitchen, and exclusive of Shop, Office, Store, Bathroom, or Pantry."

395. From the Returns submitted a record was made of 268,704 Dwellings throughout the Colony, irrespective of Race or Nationality of the occupants. Classifying these under the Race Heads to which they belong, judged by the Nationality of the Householder, we find the distribution is as follows :—

397. Taking the first three Races, and omitting the Native Huts and Dwellings, we obtain the following results :—

398. From the above, it is possible to see at a glance the relative positions of the various Races in regard to Dwellings, and it is most noticeable that the housing of the people is very similar for each Race, in each instance the average being five persons to a dwelling. Relative Positions.
