Vital workers' rights are protected by EU law:

- ✓ Equal treatment for men and women
- ✓ Maternity and paternity leave and protection during pregnancy
- ✓ Protection against discrimination based on sex, race, religion, age, disability and sexual orientation
- ✓ Health and safety standards at work: saves lives
- ✓ Maximum working hours: 48 hours and breaks
- ✓ Paid holiday leave: minimum 20 days a year
- ✓ Equal treatment for part-time workers
- ✓ Right to be kept informed of major changes including restructuring or redundancies
- ✓ Pay and conditions protected if your company is bought out
