Housing Return for England and Wales as at 31st January, 1946

This return is the first of a series of monthly progress statements on housing in England and Wales. The figures in the present return show the position up to 31st January, 1946.

This first issue includes explanatory notes to the figures which will not be repeated in subsequent returns. It also includes an Appendix A giving general tables relating to England and Wales as a whole and to various subdivisions by types of authority and by geographical distribution.

A detailed statement for each of the 1,469 housing authorities will shortly be published as a separate document (Appendix B). Future returns will be published each month to show a summary of the progress made up to the end of the preceding month for England and Wales as a whole. The more detailed tables and the statement relating to individual authorities as included in Appendices A and B will be published at longer intervals.

The Census of the housing position at 31st December, 1945, and the reports of subsequent progress to be completed regularly each month by the local authorities have been designed primarily as a guide to the progress achieved by the various local authorities and to indicate what further help or action may be required. The material contained in this return is largely derived from the Census and the reports of progress in January.

In explanation of the tabular statements set out in the return, the following summary is given of the successive steps taken since 31st March, 1945, to deal with the repair of damaged houses and the provision of temporary houses and to push forward with the erection of permanent houses.

(1) The provision of temporary houses and the acquisition and advance development of sites for houses had in fact been put in hand before 31st March, 1945.

During 1945, however, the available resources of the building industry were concentrated mainly upon the repair of war damaged dwellings—both those still in occupation and those so severely damaged as to be unfit for occupation without extensive repair. The needs of this urgent work limited, therefore, during this period the amount of work which could be undertaken on the preparation of sites for permanent and temporary houses and the construction of houses.

(2) In October 1945 the Government announced that the programme for the provision of temporary houses would be limited to the number of houses which had been allocated to local authorities for England and Wales—approximately 130,000. Under this scheme the responsibility for the acquisition of sites and for the construction of the necessary roads and sewers has been generally undertaken by the local authorities and the responsibility for the slabbing of the sites, which has to be carried out before house erection can begin, and for the erection of the houses has been undertaken by the Ministry of Works. The production of the hulls of these houses was due to begin in small numbers some time in 1945.

(3) In April, 1945, i.e., before the end of the war with Germany, local authorities were informed that they might apply to the Ministry of Health for permission to obtain tenders for permanent houses on sites ready for the immediate erection of houses, i.e., where all the necessary roads, sewers and other services had already been provided.

(4) In June, 1945, local authorities were authorized to proceed without waiting for the completion of roads and sewers on sites for permanent houses where they considered this course practicable.

(5) In August, 1945, all local authorities were instructed to put themselves in a position to obtain tenders for permanent houses as soon as possible and were encouraged to combine the necessary road works, sewers and other services with the erection of houses whenever it was considered that this

ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT OF SITES

During 1945 the energies and resources of the local authorities were concentrated on the acquisition of land and on the layout and preparation of sites for the erection of temporary houses, but a considerable volume of work for permanent housing is now being pressed forward. The following figures compare the site position of the local authorities at 31st January, 1946, with that at 31st July, 1945 (in terms of the number of houses to be provided):—

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(5) In August, 1945, all local authorities were instructed to put themselves in a position to obtain tenders for permanent houses as soon as possible and were encouraged to combine the necessary road works, sewers and other services with the erection of houses whenever it was considered that this procedure would result in better progress.

(6) In June, 1945, the Government of the day announced that the construction of houses by private builders to private contracts could be begun under licence. The granting of licences for the erection of new dwellings other than those in replacement of war destroyed dwellings is subject to conditions as to size and cost, namely:—

(a) a maximum contract or selling price of £1,200 (£1,300 in the London Region) including land, roads and services;

(b) an area limitation of 800–1,000 superficial feet in the case of two-storey houses and 730–930 superficial feet in the case of one-storey houses or flats.

The price condition must be inserted in the licence and is now enforceable for the next four years by virtue of Section 7 of the Building Materials and Housing Act, 1945.

REBUILDING OF WAR DESTROYED HOUSES

The rebuilding of war destroyed houses by private builders to private contract can be undertaken only under licence. Rebuilding by local authorities can be begun with the approval of the Ministry of Health and War Damage Commission. The position at the end of January was as follows:—

PROVISION OF OTHER HOUSING ACCOMMODATION

The number of family units of accommodation provided by the repair of unoccupied war damaged dwellings and conversions and adaptations of existing premises undertaken by private builders to private contracts is not known.

A total of 22,700 flats and houses of less than 12 rooms were released from occupation by the Services and Government Departments over the period 1st May, 1945, to 31st December, 1945. Some of the dwellings on release were taken over by the Local Authorities.

The total number of requisitioned dwellings held by the local authorities for residential purposes was 85,245 at the end of January, of these 53,223 were situated in the London region.

TOTAL PROVISION OF HOUSING ACCOMMODATION

The total number of families rehoused in the 10 months' period ended 31st January 1946—including new permanent and temporary houses, destroyed houses rebuilt and other provision as set out above—was 113,057.

Besides the provision of additional accommodation, 411,000 dwellings which were damaged during the war, but not so severely as to be unfit for occupation, were repaired during the same period.

PROGRESS OF INDIVIDUAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES

Of the total of 1,469 housing authorities there were at the 31st January, 1946, 148 authorities who had as yet no sites of which possession had been obtained. Of these authorities 91 were urban areas and 57 rural districts. There were 393 authorities who had not obtained authority to go to tender on a specific scheme. The detailed position of each housing authority under certain heads relating to permanent houses, temporary housing and to the number of licences issued to private builders under private contract will be published in Appendix B.

HOUSING LABOUR FORCE

The total number of operatives employed on the construction or repair of housing in England and Wales, including prisoners of war, grew from 324,400 in July, 1945, to 404,100 at 31st January, 1946. The following figures show the number of operatives employed in various categories in the building

and civil engineering industry in England and Wales and in Scotland respectively at 31st July, 1945, and at 31st January, 1946.

APPENDIX A NOTES

The completed Census forms relating to the housing position at 31st December, 1945, were received mainly between 8th and 12th January, 1946. At 11th February, completed Census forms had not been received from two out of the 1,469 Local Authorities.

Reports of progress in January were due to be received by 5th February, 1946. Reports received after 11th February, 1946, arrived too late to be included in the figures relating to progress in January. By 11th February, 1946, 1,379 reports had been received.

Classification of Urban and Rural Authorities

The classification of Urban Authorities other than the L.C.C. and Metropolitan Boroughs into Large Towns and Cities, Medium Towns and Cities and Small Towns has been made in terms of population. The classification has been made as follows based on the estimated population at mid-1939 as returned by the Registrar General.

Table 8 shows the number of sites at different stages from the initial stage of selection to the stage when the site is available for construction.

Between the selection of the site and the completion of houses ready for occupation there is a long chain of events equivalent to the "pipeline" of materials and components of mass production in the engineering industry.

In general the use of the site for housing requires consideration from the point of view of regional and town planning, local transport facilities and so on. Sites have then to be acquired, a layout agreed, and roads, sewers and other services provided generally in advance of beginning the actual erection of houses. The actual construction of the houses themselves is the final process in the chain of production, which also, of course, comprises the fabrication of building materials and components ready for use.

During the early stages of expanding the volume of house building the number of house sites under development and the number of houses under construction and so on will continue to rise in advance of a corresponding increase in the number of houses completed. As the production of houses by Local Authorities evolves into a smooth and continuous cycle of operations, the number of houses or house sites at the various stages in the chain of production will tend to be roughly equal.

Table 9 shows the number of houses at different stages towards completion beginning with the preparation of house plans.

Many of the initial stages in the erection of houses such as the preparation of house plans, bills of quantities and the chain of events leading to the acceptance of a tender are, in many cases, undertaken concurrently with the work of developing the corresponding sites.

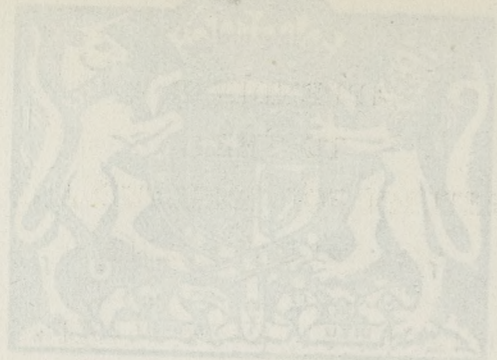
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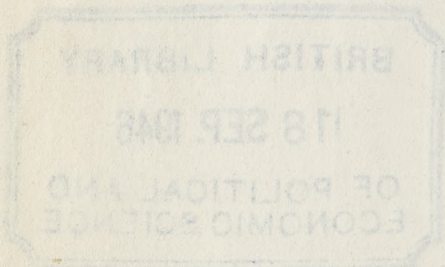

TABULAR STATEMENT FOR EACH HOUSING AUTHORITY

NOTES

1. The data shown in this Appendix has been extracted from the Census Return relating to the housing position at 31st December, 1945, and, where received, from the Progress Report for January, 1946. In certain instances the entries in the Return and Report were incomplete or inconsistent. In such instances the information contained in this Appendix has been compiled in the light of the information contained in the Return and Report as a whole. The tabular statement shows the position as at the 31st January, 1946, except for those local authorities marked with * from whom Progress Reports for January were not received in time for inclusion. The data shown for these authorities relates to the position as at the 31st December, 1945.

2. Information has been included in this Appendix from some Progress Reports received too late for inclusion in Appendix A of the Housing Return.

3. Data relating to the rebuilding of war destroyed houses by local authorities are not included in this Appendix. This particularly affects the London County Council where 60 war destroyed dwellings have been rebuilt, 238 are under construction and contracts have been let for a further 683.

4. In certain instances the Ministry of Works are undertaking the erection of groups of experimental permanent prefabricated houses on sites provided by housing authorities. These houses are not in general included in the data shown for the authorities concerned.

5. Certain authorities appear to have shown all the houses on a particular site as under construction when the contractor has begun work on the site (Column (4)).

6. The number of temporary houses allocated to housing authorities is under constant review. Where the allocation is less than the number of sites available subsequent allocations may be made (Columns (8) and (9)).

7. Where Tenders (or Estimates in the case of Direct Labour) for site development (Roads and Sewers) have been approved by the Ministry of Health but where work on the site has not yet begun, the sites have not been shown as under development (Column (2)).

8. In the few instances where sites developed before the war by private enterprise are being taken over by the local authority but possession has not yet been obtained, the relevant figures have been entered in Column (2).

9. Certain data on temporary houses in respect of Metropolitan Boroughs has been consolidated and included in the figures shown for the London County Council.
