Eight ways you can help...

1 Delivering campaign leaflets

Such as lending your front room for a coffee morning to help raise funds for the campaign.

6 Displaying a poster during the campaign

Whether in your window, your garden (or both!), it will be a visible show of support for Vote Leave.

7 Providing transport to the polls for the elderly

Could you offer a lift in your car to ensure everyone can make it to the polls?

There are many more ways to help, such as providing storage space, folding leaflets, stuffing envelopes, and more!

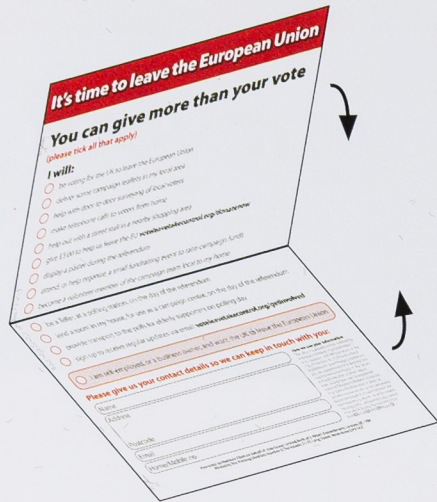
