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Local Housing Statistics

England and Wales

1. **Local Housing Statistics** has been prepared by the Ministry of Housing and Local Government and the Welsh Office to provide figures for individual local authority areas in a quarterly publication. It supersedes the former Appendix to the Housing Return for England and Wales.

Annual cumulative figures are shown in all tables, those relating to slum clearance being published one quarter later than those relating to housing progress.

2. **Definitions.** Detailed definitions of the terms used are to be found in the quarterly publication *Housing Statistics, Great Britain*. It may be noted that:

“Dwellings” included all new permanent houses and flats.

“Houses” in relation to slum clearance action has the meaning attributed to it for the purposes of Part II and Part III of the Housing Act 1957 (see 7 below).

“Local authorities” include local housing authorities and new town authorities.

“Other public authorities” include Government Departments and housing associations.

“Regions” are the economic planning regions adopted in 1965. These only differ from the Standard Statistical Regions by including Poole Borough in the South West rather than the South East.

3. **Local authority areas.** Local housing authorities may provide housing either within or outside their own areas. The figures shown in Table 5 against the name of the authority include dwellings situated outside its area, for which particulars of completions are given separately in Table 6. Authorities which have completed dwellings outside their area during the period are indicated thus § in Table 5. Authorities in whose area dwellings have been completed

by another authority are indicated thus ||. The latter include areas in which dwellings have been completed by the Greater London Council (see Table 7).

Other public sector and private sector dwellings are shown against the name of the authority in whose area they are situated.

4. **New towns.** Against the name of each new town are shown the dwellings built for the development corporation or for the Commission for the New Towns. These are all situated within the new town area and are not included in the figures for any other local authority. Private sector building within the new town area is included against the name of the authority or authorities in whose area the new town is situated, but is also shown separately in italics against the name of the new town and included in the new town total.

5. **Boundary changes.** Where the boundaries of local authority areas have been altered during the period shown, dwellings are shown in Table 5 against the local authority in whose area they are now situated.

6. **Adjustments to earlier returns** may occasionally result in a negative figure for an individual authority, when, for example, dwellings reported as started are subsequently withdrawn or there is a transfer from one sector to another.

7. **Unfit houses.** The figures in Table 5 show the number of houses in clearance orders and compulsory purchase orders confirmed under Part III of the Housing Act 1957, and houses demolished in clearance areas whether or not unfit. Houses demolished or closed elsewhere are those dealt with under Part II of the Act. The latter figures are adjusted to exclude houses reported as demolished which had previously been reported as closed.

8. **Population.** The figures are the latest available estimates of the home population prepared by the Registrar General.
