## PART IX.—DWELLINGS.

### INTRODUCTION.

The tables comprised in this part of the Report on the census of population taken on the 4th May, 1926, refer to occupied private dwellings in urban areas of the Union.

The questionnaire used at the Census of 1926 is reproduced hereunder.

### DESCRIPTION OF DWELLING.

The items followed closely those of the Census of 1921. The following are the chief differences. Item 3 was inserted to enable a discrimination to be made between the ordinary private dwelling and the type designated "privileged." The latter type embraces houses owned, for example, by a gold-mining company and leased to employees at a nominal rental, or by the South African Railway Administration and rented to employees on a salary percentage basis. Again, in certain towns, large industrial companies erect houses for their factory employees and either let the houses at a nominal rental or allow free occupation.

Item 6 was extended to show whether a house was rented furnished or unfurnished.

Item 8 was inserted to ascertain the municipal rates paid by the tenant. The practice with regard to rates varies considerably in different parts of the Union. In some towns all rates are paid by the tenant. In others some rates are paid by the landlord and others by the tenant. In others, again, the landlord pays all rates.

Item 9 was extended to ascertain not only the occupation, but certain other personal particulars of the householder. The replies to this item, however, indicate that the question was largely misunderstood, especially in regard to the term "marital condition."

The question regarding the materials of which the roof was made was omitted from the questionnaire in 1926.

**Method of Tabulation.**—The tables in this volume are not fully comparable with the tables for the previous census for the reason that separate tabulation has been made, firstly according to classes of material of the outer walls as follows—

- (i) brick, brick and stone, or concrete, or stone;
- (ii) all other materials;

and secondly by separating the privileged houses from the ordinary private dwellings.

At the Census of 1918 the questionnaire regarding the dwelling was embodied in the Householders' schedule. At the Census of 1921 a separate form was used in conjunction with a questionnaire regarding live stock in urban areas. This method of collection was not an unequalled success, and the former method of embodying the questions in the householders' form was therefore reverted to for the current census. This latter method enables information to be checked against the particulars of the household or family occupying the dwelling, and in the event of doubtful information being given in regard to any of the items of the enquiry a query can be raised or obvious adjustments made before tabulation.

A considerable number of queries were raised and referred back to the Enumerators or Supervisors for further information; but notwithstanding this endeavour to obtain as accurate a census of dwellings as possible, there was a small proportion of dwellings which had to be discarded owing to obviously incorrect particulars being furnished. This also applies to the previous censuses, and it must be understood that the total numbers of dwellings dealt with in this volume are therefore not absolute. The numbers discarded were an extremely small proportion of the total and any calculations based on the figures would not be affected. It must not be assumed that the increase in the number of dwellings between two censuses represents the total of new buildings erected during the period. Building of houses is continuously taking place; but the explanation of a part of the increase may be found in the fact that, owing to congestion, families are compelled to share houses, and frequently such portions of houses are returned as separate dwellings. As more houses become available and congestion is eased, it is conceivable that the increase shown in the number of dwellings might be less than the actual increase in the number of separate houses. Moreover, houses are sometimes pulled down to make room for improved dwellings, or for business premises.

**Scope of the Enquiry.**—With the exception of dwellings in certain rural suburbs of large towns, the tabulation has been confined to urban areas. The rural suburbs referred to are mainly

populated by persons following urban vocations in the adjacent urban centres. The housing conditions in these areas are somewhat similar to other suburban areas falling within the jurisdiction of municipal councils.

In 1926 a different method was adopted in dealing with flats, residential chambers and similar abodes. Previously, it was the practice to treat a block of residential chambers or flats as one dwelling; but for the current census, each flat, etc., was treated as a separate dwelling. This has had the effect of showing a large increase in the number of one and two-roomed dwellings, and decreasing the number of dwellings of 10 rooms and over.

It was considered that this method would overcome the numerous difficulties encountered in suitably tabulating this type of dwelling. It is certain that the new method gives a better perspective of the overcrowding or otherwise of these large residential establishments. For example, it frequently happened that a block of chambers contained say 30 rooms and 30 occupants; but as no indication was given on the forms as to how many of the rooms were unoccupied, the ordinary method of arriving at the average number of occupants per room frequently gave results very far from actual fact, especially in the poorer types of tenement building. By treating each "household" and the rooms they occupy as a separate dwelling, a more accurate picture is revealed.

**Increase in Dwellings.**—At the Censuses of 1918 and 1921 there was a considerable shortage of houses throughout the Union, with the inevitable result of overcrowding, especially in the poorer neighbourhoods. The following table gives in summarized form a comparison between the three censuses. The table refers only to private dwellings and excludes residential chambers and flats. It will be seen that the total number of private dwellings has increased considerably since the previous census, and that the distribution according to the number of rooms has changed. The predominant type has always been the 4 room dwelling, and the proportion of this class to the total has increased from 28.4 per cent. to 30.1 per cent. during the quinquennium.

**Occupants of Dwellings.**—The easing of the position as regards the overcrowding existing in 1921 is shown in the following summary. The average number of occupants per dwelling has fallen from 5.08 in 1921 to 4.89 in 1926, and is even better than in 1918, when the house shortage was first beginning to be felt. As explained previously, the position is not fully indicated by the figures owing to the requirements of enumeration and machine tabulation necessitating the method of treating each "household" as a separate entity even when two or more families are sharing one house. It is clear, however, from the last two columns of the table are compared, that in every instance the average number of occupants per private dwelling has decreased.

As might be expected with a predominance of houses of 4 rooms, 30 per cent. of the total occupants are housed in this

size of dwelling. The smaller dwellings housed a relatively smaller and the larger a relatively larger percentage of occupants of private dwellings.

**Non-European Dwellings.**—Concurrently with the European Census, an enumeration of the non-Europeans in the municipalities of Cape Town, Wynberg, Port Elizabeth, East London, and Bloemfontein was taken. The details of the dwellings occupied solely by non-Europeans are given in tables Nos. 13 to 16. The tables form interesting comparison with the housing conditions of Europeans. The following table gives a summary of the position as regards European and non-European dwellings in the three largest towns in the Cape Province. The municipality of Wynberg has been omitted as the conditions are identical with those of Cape Town. Moreover, since the date of the Census, Wynberg has been absorbed by the municipality of Cape Town, and no longer exists as a separate urban area. In the municipality of Bloemfontein complete segregation of the non-European population exists, and a comparison is thus less effectively made than in the Cape coastal towns where Europeans and non-Europeans live in neighbouring houses.

**Ownership of Private Dwellings.**—The summary given hereunder indicates the extraordinary increase in the number of houses that have been acquired by their occupiers. During the three years 1918 to 1921 there was a post war boom in house property, due largely to the shortage then existing. As a result of the increased demand during that period, many tenants were forced to purchase the house they occupied as an alternative to paying increased rent, or having the house sold over their heads. Although the proportion of owned houses has increased during the period 1921-26, the rate of increase has not been as great as the rate in the previous three years. Nevertheless, the increase is really extraordinary, and especially so in Natal, where more than half the private dwellings enumerated are now owned by the occupiers—an indication of general prosperity of the community. Conditions in the Orange Free State have remained unaltered during this period. Forty-six per cent. of the private dwellings in the Union are now owned by the occupiers.

**Dwellings occupied by both Europeans and Non-Europeans.**—In the Union, generally speaking, the housing conditions of Europeans differ considerably from those of non-Europeans. In the inland Provinces, the residential areas in towns are reserved to Europeans, while natives are confined by law to municipal locations, Asiatics to bazaars or locations, and so on. Conditions are different in the Cape Province, and in the larger towns there are often no restrictions on non-Europeans, especially in regard to the Cape coloured community. It is true that they are often found located in particular quarters of a city; but that is due to social custom and not to legal disability. In these circumstances, the better type of coloured person and the poorer type of European are often to be found living side by side, or, indeed, residing together in one house. This raised the difficulty of how to classify dwellings containing both Europeans and non-Europeans. It was found necessary to treat each case on its merits, and the following tables show the details of 574 dwellings so treated in four municipalities. 203 were classified as European and 371 as non-European dwellings.

**Unoccupied Dwellings.**—One of the duties of Enumerators in urban areas was to observe, in the course of their itinerary through their sub-districts, the number of dwellings unoccupied or in course of construction. In the case of those unoccupied, they were also requested to record as far as possible whether the dwelling was entirely vacant, or whether the occupants were temporarily absent at the time of enumeration. The results of the Enumerators' observations are given in the subjoined summary. It is realized that as far as the numbers in course of construction are concerned they may not all be private dwellings. An Enumerator's personal opinion as to what the foundations of a building in the course of erection were intended for might be erroneous. The number of such cases, however, is likely to be negligible.

With regard to the number of dwellings vacant, all those in the inland Provinces may be taken as dwellings for Europeans; but those in the coastal Provinces may be dwellings for renting to either Europeans or non-Europeans. For example, in Port Elizabeth and suburbs there were 100 houses stated to be vacant; but it cannot be assumed that all these were of the type suitable for habitation by Europeans, or even in a locality mainly populated by Europeans. Again, in Cape Town, there are areas where the two races are so intermingled that a house may alternately be let to Europeans or non-Europeans, according to whoever is the first suitable applicant for tenancy.

## ADMINISTRATIVE AREAS AND REGIONAL DIVISIONS.

In order to simplify the reading of census tables the following explanations are given of divisions and areas adopted by the Census Office for tabulation purposes. The principal terms used are (I) Provinces, (II) Regional Divisions, (III) Districts, and (IV) Areas.

Provinces, districts and areas fall under the general term of administrative areas, while regional divisions are non-administrative but are sub-divisions of the whole Union arranged as nearly as possible according to climatic conditions.

(I) *Provinces.*—These administrative areas consist of the four original states or colonies of the Cape of Good Hope, Natal, Transvaal, and the Orange Free State, which now form the Union of South Africa. The areas have remained the same, except that under Proclamation No. 145 of 1922, Walvis Bay was transferred from the Cape of Good Hope to South West Africa for administrative purposes.

(II) *Regional Divisions.*—These divisions are non-administrative, but each comprises a group of magisterial districts. In drawing the boundaries, an attempt has been made to follow closely the different climatic conditions in the Union due to altitude, varying rainfall, etc. In some cases arbitrary lines have been adopted owing to the necessity of making them coincide with the boundaries of magisterial districts.

The Union is divided into seven divisions, as follows:—

- (i) *South-Western Coastal*, extending from the Malmesbury District to the Alexandria District (inclusive).
- (ii) *South-Eastern Coastal*, which includes mainly the Coastal Districts of Transkei, Natal, and Zululand from Bathurst District in Cape Province to the border of Portuguese East Africa.
- (iii) *Karoo-Cape Central*, bounded on the South by Division (i), on the East by Division (v), and on the North by Divisions (iv) and (vii). Clanwilliam and Piquetberg are the only Districts in this Division on the Atlantic Coast.
- (iv) *Highveld*, which embraces the greater portion of the inland plateau land, and includes the whole of the Orange Free State, the inland districts of Natal, that portion of the Transvaal lying approximately south of the 25° South Latitude, and the districts of the Cape adjacent to the western boundary of the Transvaal and to the western and south-western boundary of the Orange Free State.
- (v) *Cape Thornveld*, comprising the Transkeian Hinterland and adjacent districts.
- (vi) *Transvaal Bushveld*, comprising the districts lying approximately north of the 25° South Latitude.
- (vii) *North-Western Cape*, bounded on the south-east by Divisions (iii) and (iv), on the west by the Atlantic Ocean,

and on the north by South-West Africa and Bechuanaland Protectorate.

Prior to 1926 there were only six divisions, the present Division (vii) being included in Divisions (iii) and (iv). The districts South of the Orange River formed a part of Division (iii), Karoo-Cape Central, and those north a part of Division (iv), Highveld.

(III) *Districts.*—The term "District" is used to designate the administrative area under the jurisdiction of a magistrate. There are also a number of magisterial sub-districts either falling wholly within one magisterial district or made up of portions of several districts. As these sub-districts were established primarily for the better administration of justice and do not affect the administrative functions of the parent districts from which they are formed, no cognizance is taken of them for statistical purposes other than a special tabulation of their populations.

(IV) *Areas: Urban and Rural.*—Districts are divided into urban and rural areas, as follows:—

- (i) *Urban* comprises all municipalities, village boards and councils, health committees, township local boards, and local areas possessing urban local government.
- (ii) *Rural* comprises the remainder of the district, i.e. the whole area outside urban areas.

Under rural there are the following sub-divisions:—

- (a) *Rural Suburbs.*—Certain large towns have grown so rapidly that the populations have spread beyond the boundaries of the areas of jurisdiction of the local authorities. The populations in these instances, although residing in rural areas, are suburban in character, and the majority of the residents follow urban vocations. Until these areas are absorbed by the municipality, they are designated Rural Suburbs. Unless specially mentioned, the populations of rural suburbs are not included with those of the municipalities.
- (b) *Rural Townships.*—This term is used to designate the small villages, hamlets, or other settlements which possess no local authority or government, but have populations sufficient to justify their tabulation as separate areas.
- (c) *Remaining Rural Areas*, comprising the purely farming areas outside (a) and (b).

A few districts, particularly in Natal, the Transkei, and Zululand, have no urban areas, and the districts are then entirely rural. In the majority of cases, however, the seat of the magistracy is treated as a rural township for statistical purposes.

Die punte het vrywel ooreengekom met die van die 1921-Volkstelling. Die vernaamste afwykinge was die volgende: Punt 3 is ingevoeg om verskil te kan maak tussen die gewone private woonhuis en die tiepe aangedui "as ampshalwe bewoon." Laasgenoemde tiepe omvat huise bev. wat die eiendom is van goudmynmaatskappye en teen 'n nominale huur aan die werkers verhuur word; of van die Suidafrikaanse Spoorweg-administrasie en aan die spoorwegwerkers verhuur word teen 'n huurprys na verhouding van hulle loon. Dan weer, bou groot industriële maatskappye in sekere stede huise vir hulle fabriekswerkers en verhuur die teen 'n nominale huurprys of laat hulle werkers die huise kosteloos bewoon.

Punt 6 is uitgebrei om aan te toon of 'n huis gemeubiler of ongemeubiler gehuur was.

Punt 8 is ingevoeg om na te gaan hoeveel deur die huurder aan munisipale belasting betaal word. Die praktyk hieromtrent verskil belangrik in die verskillende dele van die Unie. In sommige stede word al sulke belasting deur die huurder betaal. In ander stede word dit gedeeltelik deur die huiseienaar betaal en gedeeltelik deur die huurder. In sommige stede betaal die huiseienaar alle belastinge.

Punt 9 is uitgebrei om na te gaan, nie alleen wat beroep die huishouer gevolg het nie, dog ook om sekere andere persoonlike besonderhede van hom te verkry. Hierdie vraag blyk egter vry algemeen misverstaan te wees, vernaamlik met betrekking tot die uitdrukking "huwelikstaat."

Die vraag betreffende dakmateriaal is uit die vraelys in 1926 weggelaat.

**Metode van Tabulasie.**—Die tabelle in hierdie volume is nie heeltemal vergelykbaar met die tabelle van die vorige Volkstelling nie, om rede dat 'n afsonderlike tabulasie gemaak is, eerstens volgens materiaalsoorte van die buitenure, en wel as volg:—

(i) Baksteen, baksteen en klip, of konkreet, of klip;

(ii) alle ander materiale;

en tweedens deur die ampshalwe-bewoonde huise af te skei van die gewone private woonhuise.

By die Sensus van 1918 is die vrae betreffende woninge opgeneem in die huishouer se vraelys. By die Volkstelling van 1921 was 'n afsonderlike vorm gebruik in verband met die vrae betreffende lewende huise in stedelike gebied. Hierdie metode van insameling van gegewens was nie bepaald 'n sukses nie, en daarom is teruggekeer na die vroeëre metode om die vrae in die huishouersvorm in te sluit vir die lopende Sensus. Hierdie laasgenoemde metode het in staat gestel om die gegewens te toets aan die besonderhede van die huishouer of gesin wat die huise bewoon, en in geval van twyfelagtige informasie met betrekking tot punte van die ondersoek, kon voor die tabulasie so'n onjuistheid of onduidelikheid reggemaak word.

'n Belangrike aantal twyfelagtige punte moes na die opnemers of kontroleurs verwys word vir opheldering, dog nieteenstaande hierdie poging om 'n so noukeurig moontlike sensus van woninge te verkry, was daar 'n klein hoeveelheid huise wat weens in-die-oogvallende, onjuiste besonderhede buite rekening moes gelaat word. Dis ook van toepassing op vorige Volkstellinge, en dit moet in hierdie volume behandel, om daardie rede nie die volstrekte aantal uitmaak nie. Die buite-rekening-gelate hoeveelhede was uiters klein en sal heeltemal geen invloed hê op enige berekening wat op die syfers gegrond word nie. Dit moet nie aangeneem word nie dat die verhoging in die aantal woninge tussen die beide volkstellinge, die totaal van nu-geboude huise gedurende die tydperk verteenwoordig. Die oprigting van huise gaan gereeld voort, dog 'n gedeelte van die vermeerdering vind sy verklaring in die omstandigheid dat weens opeenhoping, die huisgesinne genoodsaak word om huise te deel, en dikwels word sulke gedeeltes van huise as afsonderlike woninge opgegee. As meer huise beskikbaar kom en die opeenhoping minder word, dan is dit begryplik dat die aangetoonde verhoging in die hoeveelheid woninge minder kan wees dan die werklike verhoging in die hoeveelheid afsonderlike huise. Bowendien word somtyds huise afgebreek om plek te maak vir verbeterde woninge of vir besigheidspersone.

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**Omvang van die Onderzoek.**—Met uitsondering van woninge in sekere plattelandse voorstede van groot stede, is die tabulasie beperk gewees tot stedelike gebied. Die bogenoemde plattelandse voorstede is hoofsaaklik bevolk deur persone wat hulle besigheid of beroep in die naburige stad uitoefen. Die huisvesting is in hierdie streke min of meer gelyk aan ander voorstedelike streke, wat binne die regsbevoegdheid van die munisipale rade val.

In 1926 is 'n ander metode gevolg met die behandeling van apartemente, woonkamerverdiepinge en soortgelyke woonplekke. Vroeër was dit die praktyk om 'n blok van woonkamerverdiepinge of apartemente as één woning te beskou, dog by hierdie sensus is elk apartement, ens., as een afsonderlike woning beskou. Dit het 'n groot vermeerdering in die aantal van een- en twee-kamer huise teweeggebring en die aantal woninge van tien kamers en meer verminder.

Oorweeg was dat hierdie metode die talryke moeilikhede by 'n behoorlike tabulasie van sulke woninge uit die weg sou ruim. Dis seker dat die nuwe metode 'n beter oorsig gee van opeenhoping in hierdie dig-bevolkte inrigtinge. Bev. dit gebeur dikwels dat 'n huis van kamerverdiepinge, sê 30 kamers en 30 bewoners tel; dog aangesien geen verklaring op die vorm voorkom betreffende die hoeveelheid onbewoonde kamers, het die metode van berekening van die gemiddelde aantal bewoners per kamer dikwels resultate opgelewer, wat baie ver van die werklike toestand is, vernaamlik in die armer tiepes van apartemente.

**Vermeerdering van Woninge.**—By die Volkstelling van 1918 en 1921 was daar 'n belangrike tekort van huise oor die hele Unie, met die onvermydelike gevolg van opeenhoping, vernaamlik in die armer buurte. Die volgende tabel gee 'n vergelykende oorsig tussen die drie Volkstellinge. Die tabel het alleen betrekking op private woninge en laat woonkamerverdiepinge en apartemente buite rekening. Dit blyk dat die totale hoeveelheid private woninge belangrik toegeneem het sedert die vorige Sensus, en dat die distribusie volgens die aantal kamers gewysig is. Die meesvoorkomende tiepe is altyd die vier-kamer woning gewees, en die verhouding van hierdie klas tot die totaal het gedurende die vyfjarige tydperk van 28.4 persent tot 30.1 persent gestyg.

**Bewoners van Huise.**—Die verligting van die toestand in verband met opeenhoping, wat in 1921 bestaan het, blyk uit die volgende oorsig. Die gemiddelde aantal bewoners per huis het gedaal van 5.08 in 1921 tot 4.89 in 1926, en die toestand is selfs beter dan in 1918, toe die tekort van huise in die oog begin te val het. Soos vroeër duidelik gemaak, word die toestand nie volledig deur die syfers weerspieël nie, aangesien die opnemers in masjiene-tabulasie die metode van behandeling van elk "huishouer" as 'n afsonderlike eenheid noodsaaklik gemaak het, selfs wanneer twee of meer huisgesinne eenselfde huis bewoon het. Dit is egter by vergelyking van die laaste twee kolomme van die tabel duidelik dat die gemiddelde aantal bewoners per private huis in ieder geval verminder is.

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Soos met 'n oorwig van vier-kamer huise verwag kan word, woon dertig persent van die totaal in huise van hierdie grootte. Die kleiner huise het onderdak verskaaf aan 'n *betreklik* kleiner, en die groter huise aan 'n *betreklik* groter persentasie van bewoners van private huise.

**Nie-Europese Woninge.**—Tegelykertyd met die Europese Volkstelling is in die munisipaliteite van Kaapstad, Wynberg, Port Elizabeth, Oos-Londen en Bloemfontein ook die Nie-Europese bevolking opgeneem. Die besonderhede van die huise, uitsluitend bewoon deur nie-Europese, word in tabelle Nos. 13 tot 16 gegee. Die tabelle verskaaf interessante vergelykinge met die huisvesting van Europese. Die volgende tabel gee 'n oorsig van die toestand met betrekking tot die huisvesting van Europese en nie-Europese in die drie grootste stede van die Kaapprovinsie. Die munisipaliteit van Wynberg is buite rekening gelaat, aangesien die toestand daar ooreenkom met die in Kaapstad. Bowendien is Wynberg sedert die sensus-datum in die munisipaliteit van Kaapstad opgeneem, en bestaan dus nie langer as 'n afsonderlike stedelike gebied nie. In die munisipaliteit van Bloemfontein bestaan volledige afsondering van die nie-Europese bevolking en hierdie stad kan derhalwe eintlik nie vergelyk word met die Kaapse kusstede nie, waar Europese en nie-Europese in dieselfde buurte woon.

**Besitreg van Private Woninge.**—Die onderstaande oorsig weerspieël die buitengewone vermeerdering in die aantal huise, wat deur die bewoners aangekoop is. Gedurende die drie jaar van 1918 tot 1921, onmiddellik na die oorlog, is sterk gespekuleer in huiseiendom, grotendeels toe te skrywe aan die bestaande tekort van woninge. Tengevolge van die groter vraag gedurende daardie tydperk, was baie huurders genoodsaak om die huise deur hulle bewoon aan te koop, aangesien hulle anders hoër huur sou moet betaal, of miskien by verkoop aan iemand anders die huise sou moet ontruim. Ofskoon die persentasie van bewoners-eie-huise gedurende die tydperk 1921-26 gestyg het, is die persentasieverhoging nie so groot gewees as in die vorige drie jaar nie. Nietemin is die verhoging werklik buitengewoon, en vernaamlik in Natal, waar meer dan die helfte van die private huise wat opgeneem is, nou deur die bewoners gekoop is. Dit gee 'n aanwysing van die algemene welvaart van die gemeenskap. In die Oranje Vrystaat is die toestand gedurende hierdie tydperk onveranderd gebley. Ses-en-veertig persent van die private huise in die Unie is nou die eiendom van hulle bewoners.

**Huise sowel deur Europeane as nie-Europeane bewoon.**—Oor die algemene verskil die huisvesting van Europeane in die Unie belangrik van die van nie-Europeane. In die binnelandse provinsies is die woningwyke in stede vir Europese gereserveer, terwyl die natuurlike volgens wet in munisipale lokasies gehuisves word, die Asiëte in basaars of lokasies, ens. Die toestand is verskillend in die Kaapprovinsie en in die groter stede bestaan daar dikwels geen beperkinge op nie-Europeane, vernaamlik ten opsigte van die Kaapse kleurlinge nie. Dis waar dat hulle dikwels in 'n bepaalde buurt van 'n stad aangetref word, dog dit is toe te skrywe aan die gemeenskapsgees en nie aan wetlike beperkinge nie. Onder hierdie omstandighede word die beter klas kleurlinge en die armer klas Europeane dikwels naasmekaar wonende aangetref, of inderdaad saamwonende in een huis. Dit het aanleiding gegee tot moeilikheid by die rangskikking van woninge wat sowel Europeane as nie-Europeane huisves. Dis nodig gevind om elke geval afsonderlik na te gaan, en die volgende tabelle verskaaf besonderhede van 574 woninge, so behandel, in vier munisipaliteite. 203 is gerangskik as Europeane en 371 as nie-Europese bewone.

**Onbewoonde Huise.**—Een van die verpligtinge van opnemers in stedelike gebied was om in die loop van hulle rondreis deur hulle sub-distrikte, die aantal onbewoonde huise en die in aanbou, op te neem. Met betrekking tot onbewoonde huise, was aan hulle ook opgedra om soveel moontlik uit te vind of die woning heeltemal ontruim was, of dat die bewoners op daardie oomblik tydelik afwesig was. Die resultate van die opnemer se waarneminge word in die onderstaande oorsig gegee. Virsover as dit hoeveelhede in aanbou betref, moet toegestem word dat dit miskien nie almal private woninge is. Die persoonlike opinie van 'n opnemer met betrekking tot die bestemming van 'n gebou, waaraan gewerk word, kan verkeerd wees. Die aantal van sulke gevalle egter, is waarskynlik onbetekenend.

Met betrekking tot die aantal vakante woninge, kan dié in die binnelandse provinsies beskou word as huise vir Europeane; dog die in die kusprovinsies kan huurhuise wees sowel vir Europeane as vir nie-Europeane. Bev., was daar in Port Elizabeth en voorstede 100 huise opgegee as vakant; dog dit kan nie aangeneem word dat al hierdie huise van 'n geskikte tiepe was vir bewoning deur Europeane, of selfs in 'n buurt wat hoofsaaklik deur Europeane bewoon word. Dan weer, bestaan daar in Kaapstad buurte waar die beide rasse so deurmekaar woon, dat 'n huis by afwisseling nou aan 'n Europeaan en dan weer aan 'n nie-Europeaan verhuur word, afhanklik van watter persoon daarvoor die eerste aansoek doen.

## ADMINISTRATIEWE STREKE EN LANDAFDELINGE.

Om die bestudering van die sensustabelle te vereenvoudig, word die volgende verklaring van die indeling gegee wat deur die Sensuskantoor vir tabulasie-doeleindes aangeneem is. Die vernaamste toegepaste terme is die volgende: (I) Provinsies, (II) Landafdelinge, (III) Distrikte en (IV) Streke.

Provinsies, distrikte en streke val onder die algemene term van administratiewe streke, terwyl landafdelinge nie-administratiewe streke is, dog onderafdelinge van die gehele Unie, soveel moontlik afgebaken volgens klimaattoestande.

(I) *Provinsies.*—Hierdie administratiewe landstreke bestaan uit die vier oorspronklike state of kolonies van die Kaap, Natal, Transvaal en Oranje Vrystaat, wat nou die Unie van Suid-Afrika vorm. Die landstreke is onveranderd gebly, behalwe dat volgens Proklamasie No. 145 van 1922 Walvisbaai van die Kaapprovinsie vir administratiewe doeleindes na Suidwes-Afrika oorgebring is.

(II) *Landafdelinge.*—Hierdie afdelinge is nie-administratief, dog elk omvat 'n groep van magistraatsdistrikte. By bepaling van die grense is soveel moontlik rekening gehou met die verskillende klimaattoestande in die Unie, veroorsaak deur verskil in hoogte, reënval, ens. In sommige gevalle is willekeurige lyne getrek weens die noodsaaklikheid om die grense te laat saamval met die van die magistraatsdistrikte.

Die Unie is verdeel in sewe afdelinge en wel as volg:—

- (i) *Suidwes-kus*, lopende van die Malmesbury-distrik tot en met insluiting van die Alexandria-distrik.
- (ii) *Suidoos-kus*, wat hoofsaaklik die kusdistrikte van Transkei, Natal en Soeloeland insluit, vanaf Bathurst-distrik in die Kaapprovinsie tot die grens van Portugees-Oos-Afrika.
- (iii) *Karo-Kaap Sentraal*, ten suide begrens deur Afdeling (i), ten ooste deur Afdeling (v) en ten noorde deur Afdelinge (iv) en (vii). Clanwilliam en Piquetberg is die enigste distrikte in hierdie Afdeling aan die Atlantiese Kus.
- (iv) *Hoëveld*, wat die grootste gedeelte van die inlandse plato omvat, en die hele Oranje Vrystaat, die inlandse distrikte van Natal, daardie gedeelte van die Transvaal wat nagenoeg suid van die 25° S.B. lê, en die distrikte van die Kaap aan die westelike grens van die Transvaal en tot aan die westelike en suidwestelike grens van die Oranje Vrystaat insluit.
- (v) *Kaap-doringveld*, wat bestaan uit die Transkei-hinterland en aangrensende distrikte.
- (vi) *Transvaal-bosveld*, omvattende die distrikte wat nagenoeg noord van die 25° S.B. lê.
- (vii) *Noordwestelike Kaap*, begrens aan die suidooste deur Afdelinge (iii) en (iv) en aan die weste deur die Atlantiese Oseaan en aan die noorde deur Suidwes-Afrika en Betsjoeanaland-protectoraat.

Voor 1926 was daar maar ses Afdelinge, en die teenswoordige Afdeling (vii) was ingesluit in Afdelinge (iii) en (iv). Die distrikte ten suide van die Oranjerivier het deel uitgemaak van Afdeling (iii), Karo-Kaap Sentraal, en die ten noorde van Afdeling (iv), Hoëveld.

(III) *Distrikte.*—Die term distrik word gebruik om die administratiewe landstreek aan te dui, wat onder die regsbevoegdheid van 'n magistraat staan. Daar is ook 'n aantal magistraats-subdistrikte wat óf binne een magistraatsdistrik val óf opgemaak is van gedeeltes van verskeie distrikte. Aangesien hierdie subdistrikte in die eerste plek gevorm is ter vergemakliking van regspleging en geen wysiging bring in die administratiewe funksies van die hoofdistrikte, waarvan hulle afgesny is, word daarmee vir statistiese doeleindes geen rekening gehou nie met uitsondering van 'n spesiale tabulasie van hulle bevolking.

(IV) *Streke: Stedelike en Platteland.*—Distrikte word verdeel in stedelike en plattelandse streke, en wel as volg:—

- (i) *Stedelik*, omvattende alle munisipaliteite, dorpsbesture en-rade, gesondheidskomitees, lokale dorpsrade en lokale besture met bevoegdheid van stedelike lokale bestuur.
- (ii) *Platteland*, bestaande uit die res van die distrik, d.i. die gehele oppervlakte behalwe die stedelike gebied.

Die platteland word in die volgende onderafdelinge verdeel:—

- (a) *Plattelandse Voorstede.*—Seker groot stede het so snel uitgebrei dat die bevolking buite die grense van die regsbevoegdheid van die plaaslike bestuur versprei is. Die bevolking, hoewel in hierdie gevalle op die platteland wonende, is stedelik van karakter en die meerderheid van die bewoners het hulle besigheid in die stad. Totdat sulke streke deur die munisipaliteit oorgeneem word sal hulle as plattelandse voorstede beskou word. Tensy spesiaal vermeld, word die bevolking van plattelandse voorstede nie by die van die munisipaliteite ingesluit nie.
- (b) *Buitedorpe.*—Hierdie term word gebruik om klein dorpie of klein nedersettinge aan te dui, wat geen plaaslike bestuur besit nie, dog waar voldoende mense woon om hulle tabulasie afsonderlik te regverdig.
- (c) *Res van die Platteland*, wat uit die eintlike landboustreke bestaan buitekant (a) en (b).

'N paar distrikte, hoofsaaklik in Natal, die Transkei en Soeloeland, het geen stedelike gebied, en die distrikte is dus heeltemal platteland. In die meeste gevalle, egter, word die setel van die magistraat as 'n buitedorp beskou vir statistiese doeleindes.
