Part IV.—Birthplaces of the People.

175. The instructions given on the Householders Schedule for the guidance of persons in recording information relating to "Birthplaces" were as follows. Birthplaces of the People.

Do not enter the names of Towns or Provinces, or Individual State of Federations, but give the names of Countries, as for instance, England, Scotland, France, Australia, India, America. Country where born.

If not born in Natal, state length of residence in Natal; if less than a year, insert a "X."

176. This Table gives the Birthplaces of all persons for each Census area separately, whilst a Summary is given also for the whole Colony. From these it will be seen that 995,862 persons were born in "Africa," 42,556 in "Europe," 65,991 in "Asia," 930 in "America," 3,305 in "Australia," and 58 "At Sea," and "Unknown or Unspecified" 52. Part IV.—Table I. See Annexures.

177. The relative proportions per cent. of the persons born in the various Continents are as follows:—"Africa" 89·81 per cent., "Europe" 3·83, "Asia" 5·95, "America" 0·08, "Australia" 0·29, "At Sea," 0·0052, and "Unknown or Unspecified" 0·0046. Proportion per cent.

178. The subjoined Table shows the exact position in relation to the Total Population of the Colony, Males and Females, collectively, of the number of persons born in the various Countries, that is, the relative proportion per cent. Birthplaces detailed.

179. The figures given under the sub-heads "Natal" and "Zululand" are exceptionally large, owing to the number of the Native Population included. It is thus evident from the above Table that, of the total population throughout the whole Colony, the greatest number of people were born in "Natal," viz., 754,313 persons, or 68.03 per cent. of the entire Population.

Next in order of merit, so far as numbers are concerned, we have the "Zululand" born (mostly Natives), viz., 218,926 persons, or 19.74 per cent. Next follow the "Indian" born, with 65,720 persons, or 5.92 per cent., and then persons born in "England and Wales," with 25,891, or 2.33 per cent.

180. The subjoined Table shows the relative positions, proportionately, per cent. of the number of persons born in each portion of any one of the Continents in relation to the entire number of persons born in any one particular Continent of which the portion referred to forms a part, as, for instance, there are 754,313 persons born in "Natal," and "Natal" forming a portion of the "Continent of Africa," in which 995,862 persons residing in "Natal" were born, the relative proportion per cent. of "Natal" born persons in relation to the entire "African" born Population is 75.74 per cent.; and again, there are 25,891 persons born in "England and Wales," and "England and Wales" forming a portion of the "Continent of Europe," with a record of 42,566 persons European born, residing in "Natal," the relative proportion per cent. of persons born in "England and Wales" in relation to the entire "European" born population (that is, persons born in "European" Countries or Provinces), is 60.83, per cent.

181. So it is evident that of the "African" born Races, in point of numbers, the persons born in "Zululand" are second in importance to the "Natal" born, with a relative proportion per cent. of 21.98 resident in this Colony. "Cape Colony" follows in order of merit, supplying 0.64 per cent., then the "Transvaal" with 0.62 per cent., succeeded by the "Orange River Colony" with 0.23 per cent.

182. Of the persons born in the Provinces or Countries of Europe, "England and Wales" heads the list with 60.83 per cent., followed by "Scotland" with 20.45 per cent., "Ireland" with 5.23 per cent., and then "Germany" with 4.50 per cent., and so on.

183. Of the persons born in Asia, "India" furnishes nearly the whole, with 99.58 per cent.

184. Of America, the "United States" head the list with 56.56 per cent., followed by "Canada" with 25.80 per cent., whilst "Other" American Countries supply 17.63 per cent.

185. Of Australasia, 2,861 or 86.56 per cent. were born in Australia alone, 11.10 per cent. in "New Zealand," and 1.93 per cent. in "Tasmania." 0.39 per cent. recorded their birthplaces, in Australasia so indefinitely, as to preclude any possibility of classification.

186. These figures for Australasia should be compared with the figures given under "Nationalities," where only 240 persons are recorded as "Australians," and 17 as "New Zealanders." The previous remarks concerning the impossibility to account for the irregular manner in which Australian born persons have recorded their Nationality, some giving the Nationality of their Parents, and some recording themselves as "Australians," are again applicable here.

187. We have a record of 58 persons born "At Sea," while it is satisfactory to note that out of the total population only 52 persons were unable to give their place of birth.

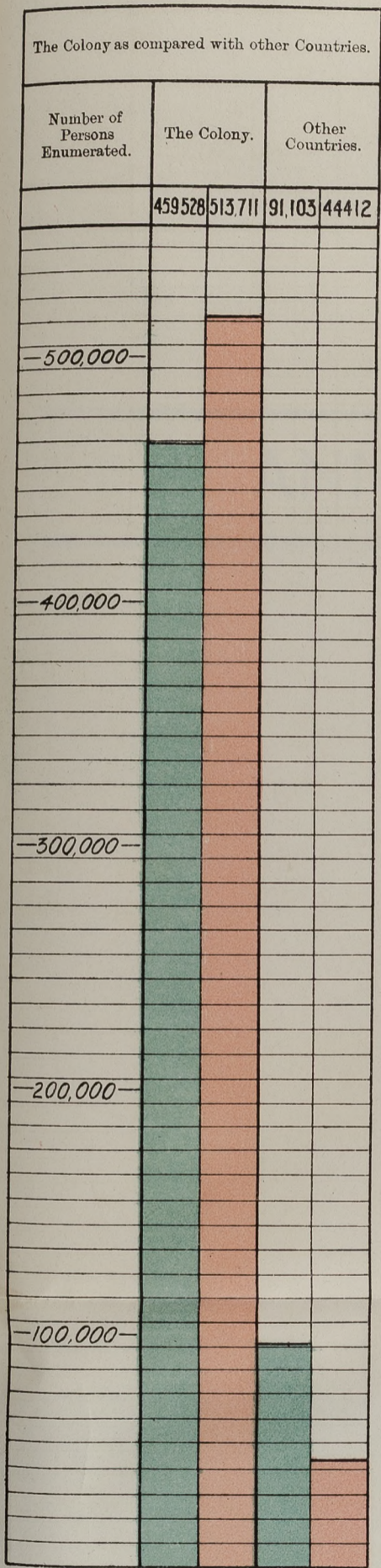
189. Thus, we observe there are 459,528 Males and 513,711 Females (total 973,239) born in the Colony, compared with 91,103 Males and 44,412 Females (Total 135,515) not born in the Colony.

190. Of those not born in the Colony, there are born in "Other British African Possessions" 11,192 Males and 8,288 Females (Total 19,480); in "Other African States," 2,101 Males and 1,042 Females (Total 3,143).

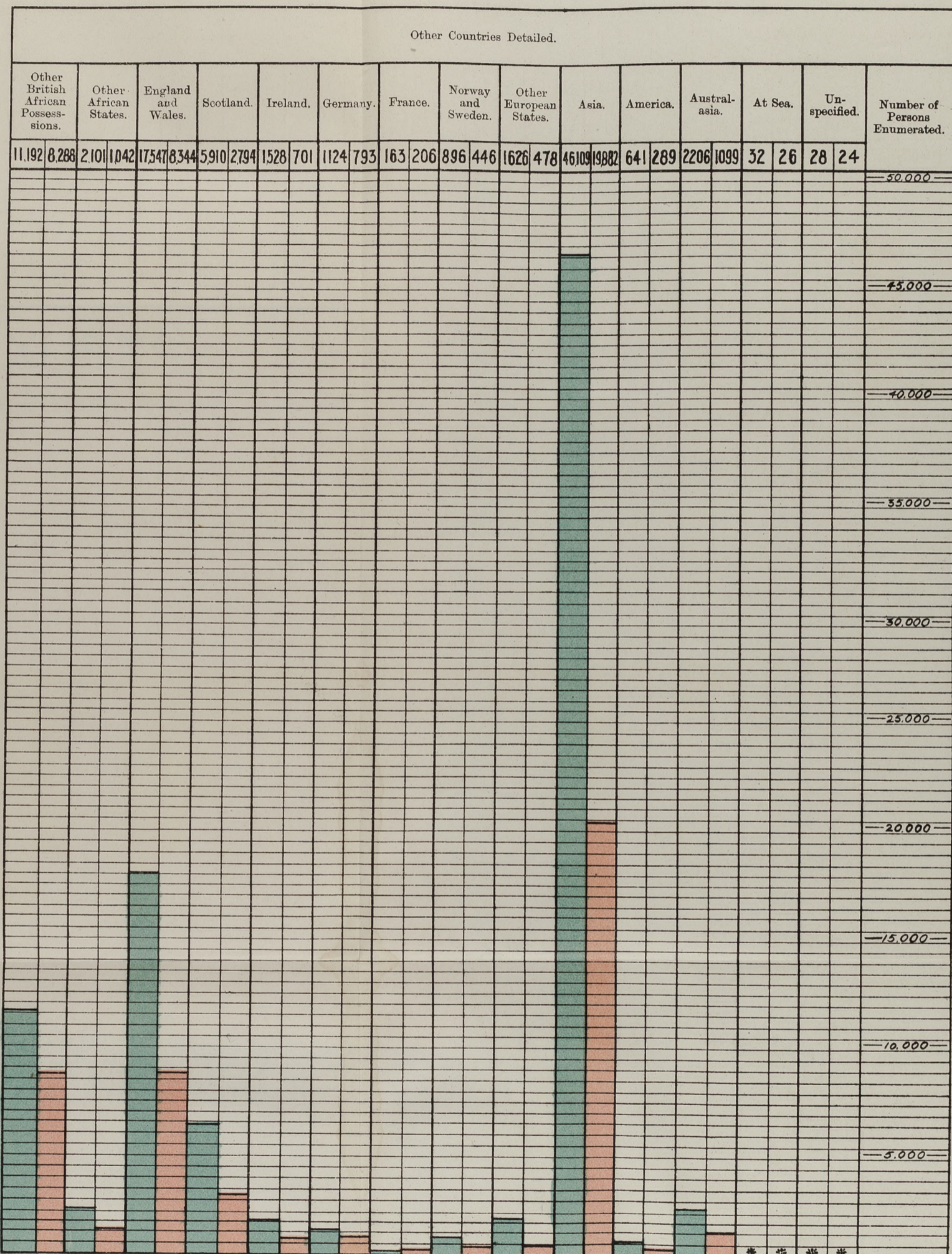
COLONY OF NATAL. CENSUS, 1904.

Part V.—Education of the People.

191. In dealing with Educational Returns, it is only in a very restricted sense that statistical information gained by ordinary Census methods, can be accepted as an index of the "Education of the People," notwithstanding there is much to be gained by the knowledge obtained from the statistics which disclose the proportion of persons who can Read and Write, at each age period, and extent to which these are availed of at school age in every part of the Colony. Thus, although directly, the comparative power to Read and Write at each age, and in each District, gives little information of the nature and extent of Education imparted, it is an index in revealing comparatively how far the ordinary common school system extends, or is lacking, and it also affords a safe measure in gauging the success attained in other branches of Education, which are the usual concomitants of tuition in Reading and Writing in any tongue. As the power to Read and Write is regarded mainly as the evidence of the possession of a certain amount of intelligence obtained from the training in all other matters which is the common school's curriculum, it has been deemed advisable to include all foreigners who can Read and Write under this category.

192. In making comparisons, it is obvious that all Infants and Children not yet arrived at the age for training in Reading and Writing should be excluded, for it is the result of the training at the normal tutelary stage which should be sought for, rather than the misleading averages, which include not only the young, under and during the age of the persons whose average tends to conceal the success or otherwise of the existing machinery provided for the education of the young of the Colony.

193. The following instructions were given on the Householder's Schedule for the information of persons, recording the Educational Status of the inmates:—

Write "C.R." for "Cannot Read," "R." for "Read Only," "R.W." for "Read and Write," add "F" if only able to "Read and Write" in a foreign language. If a University Graduate, state Degree and University.

Where receiving instruction, write:—

"C." if at College, Grammar or High School.

"P." if at Private School.

"A.D." if at a Denominational Aided School.

"H." if receiving instruction at Home.

194. In addition to the information elicited through the medium of the Householder's Schedule, a special Educational Form was supplied to all Educational Institutions, public or private, throughout the Colony. This Form is of exceptional value, for through it alone have we been enabled to obtain any record of the Natives receiving instruction.

195. Through the medium of the Householder's Forms, we are enabled to furnish the information contained in these Tables. For each Census Area, separately, a record is given, under the various Nationalities, of all Children receiving instruction, under the sub-heads:—"College," "Private School," "Aided Denominational School," "Home," "Government," and "Not Specified."

196. The first Table relates to the "European or White" Children only, from which it will be seen that a record is given of 19,274; the second to "Indian and Asiatic" Children, in all 13,365; the third to "Mixed and Others," total 1,295; whilst the "Native" Children, in the fourth Table, number 12,888. Thus we have a total record of 46,822 Children receiving instruction throughout the Colony.

197. The Summary at the end shows the relative position of Children receiving Education, and from this Summary we are able to discern at what class of School the children in the Colony are being educated. Thus, we have 3,041 Children (European) being educated at "College," or 15.77 per cent. of the total European Children receiving tuition, 3,304 or 17.14 per cent. at "Private" Schools, and so on with the remainder.

198. Of the European Children, we observe that the greatest number are given as being educated at "Home." Taking into consideration the isolated positions of so many families on Farms, we believe this may be the case, but what class of Education the majority of these Children may be receiving we are not in a position to state.

199. We observe a number of "Indian and Asiatic" also "Mixed and Others" Children are shown as attending College.
