Housing Return for England and Wales as at 28th February, 1946

This return is the second of a series of monthly progress statements on housing in England and Wales. The figures in the present return show the position up to 28th February, 1946.

The *first issue included explanatory notes to the figures which have not been repeated in this return. It also includes an Appendix A giving general tables relating to England and Wales as a whole and to various subdivisions by types of authority and by geographical distribution.

A detailed statement for each of the 1,469 housing authorities will shortly be published as a separate document (Appendix B).

It has become apparent from data recently available, that the estimated number of houses shown in the January return as under construction, was too low. It is estimated that at the end of February the number of houses under construction was about 13,000.

REBUILDING OF WAR DESTROYED HOUSES

The rebuilding of war destroyed houses by private builders to private contract can be undertaken only under licence. Rebuilding by local authorities can be begun with the approval of the Ministry of Health and War Damage Commission. PROVISION OF OTHER HOUSING ACCOMMODATION

The number of family units of accommodation provided by the repair of unoccupied war damaged dwellings and conversions and adaptations of existing premises undertaken by private builders to private contracts is not known.

A total of 24,147 flats and houses of less than 12 rooms were released from occupation by the Services and Government Departments over the period 1st May, 1945, to 31st January, 1946. Some of the dwellings on release were taken over by the local authorities.

The total number of requisitioned dwellings held by the local authorities for residential purposes was 85,927 at the end of February, of these 53,618 were situated in the London region.

TOTAL PROVISION OF HOUSING ACCOMMODATION

The total number of houses and other family units of accommodation provided in the 11 months' period ended 28th February, 1946—including new permanent and temporary houses, destroyed houses rebuilt and other provision as set out above—was 122,911.

Besides the provision of additional accommodation, 447,400 dwellings which were damaged during the war, but not so severely as to be unfit for occupation, were repaired during the same period.

PROGRESS OF INDIVIDUAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES

Of the total of 1,469 housing authorities there were at the 28th February, 1946, 118 authorities who had as yet no sites of which possession had been obtained. Of these authorities 71 were urban areas and 47 rural districts. There were 268 authorities who had not obtained authority to go to tender on a specific scheme. The detailed position of each housing authority under certain heads relating to permanent houses, temporary housing and to the number of licences issued to private builders under private contract will be published in Appendix B.

HOUSING LABOUR FORCE

The total number of operatives, excluding prisoners-of-war, employed on the construction or repair of housing in England and Wales, whether on work for local authorities or on private contracts grew from 324,400 in July, 1945, to 410,000 at 28th February, 1946. At 31st January, 1946, the number so

employed was 404,100. Within the total housing labour force, the number employed on war damage repairs decreased from 197,100 at 31st January to 184,200 at 28th February, while the number employed on the construction of permanent houses grew from 32,400 to 44,100.

APPENDIX A NOTES

The material contained in this return is derived from a census of the housing position at 31st December, 1945, and the reports of subsequent progress completed by the local authorities. At 15th March, only one out of the 1,469 local authorities had not returned a completed census form. By the same date, reports of progress in January had not been received from 7 authorities. Reports of progress in February were due to be received by the 5th March, 1946. Reports received after 11th March arrived too late to be included in the figures shown in this report relating to progress in February. By 11th March, 1946, 1,364 reports had been received.

Classification of Urban and Rural Authorities

The classification of Urban Authorities other than the L.C.C. and Metropolitan Boroughs into Large Towns and Cities, Medium Towns and Cities and Small Towns has been made in terms of population. The classification has been made as follows based on the estimated population at mid-1939 as returned by the Registrar General.

Table 8 shows the number of sites at different stages from the initial stage of selection to the stage when the site is available for construction.

Between the selection of the site and the completion of houses ready for occupation there is a long chain of events equivalent to the "pipeline" of materials and components of mass production in the engineering industry.

In general the use of the site for housing requires consideration from the point of view of regional and town planning, local transport facilities and so on. Sites have then to be acquired, a layout agreed, and roads, sewers and other services provided generally in advance of beginning the actual erection of houses. The actual construction of the houses themselves is the final process in the chain of production, which also, of course, comprises the fabrication of building materials and components ready for use.

During the early stages of expanding the volume of house building, the number of house sites under development and the number of houses under construction and so on will continue to rise in advance of a corresponding increase in the number of houses completed. As the production of houses by Local Authorities evolves into a smooth and continuous cycle of operations, the number of houses or house sites at the various stages in the chain of production will tend to be roughly equal.

Table 9 shows the number of houses at different stages towards completion beginning with the preparation of house plans.

Many of the initial stages in the erection of houses such as the preparation of house plans, bills of quantities and the chain of events leading to the acceptance of a tender are, in many cases, undertaken concurrently with the work of developing the corresponding sites.

NOTES

1. An alphabetical index of Regions and Counties is shown on page 76.
2. The data shown in this Appendix has been based on Appendix B to the Housing Return for England and Wales for the 31st January, 1946, and includes additions and alterations notified in the Progress Report for February, 1946, received from Local Authorities. In cases where entries in the Progress Report were incomplete or inconsistent the information contained in this Appendix has been compiled in the light of evidence contained in the Census Return and in the Progress Reports as a whole. The tabular statement shows the position as at the 28th February, 1946. In certain instances Progress Reports for January and February have not been received in time for inclusion. Those local authorities in respect of whom no information from Progress Reports have been included are marked with * ; those in respect of whom information from the Progress Report for January only have been included are marked with †. The data in respect of permanent housing shown for such authorities relates to the position as at the 31st December, 1945, and 31st January, 1946, respectively.
3. Information has been included in this Appendix from some Progress Reports received too late for inclusion in Appendix A of the Housing Return.
4. Data relating to the rebuilding of war destroyed houses by local authorities are not included in this Appendix. This particularly affects the London County Council where 77 war destroyed dwellings have been rebuilt, 560 are under construction and contracts have been let for a further 703.
5. The term "under construction" in Column (4) means that the contractor has actually begun work on the construction of the dwellings. In some instances work has begun on all dwellings in a particular contract ; in other instances it would appear that all the dwellings in a particular scheme have been shown as "under construction" on the Progress Report although work has not necessarily started on all of them.
6. In certain instances the Ministry of Works are undertaking the erection of groups of experimental permanent prefabricated houses on sites provided by housing authorities. These houses are not in general included in the data shown for the authorities concerned.
7. The number of temporary houses allocated to housing authorities is under constant review. Where the allocation is less than the number of sites available subsequent allocations may be made (Columns (8) and (9)).
8. Where Tenders (or Estimates in the case of Direct Labour) for site development (Roads and Sewers) have been approved by the Ministry of Health but where work on the site has not yet begun, the sites have not been shown as under development (Column (2)).
9. In the few instances where sites developed before the war by private enterprise are being taken over by the local authority but possession has not yet been obtained, the relevant figures have been entered in Column (2).
10. Permanent Houses. The figures in all columns except Column (4) are not included in any other column. "Houses under construction" shown in Column (4) are included in "Houses on Tenders Approved" quoted in Column (3).
11. Certain data on temporary houses in respect of the London County Council and Metropolitan Boroughs have been consolidated.
