RIGHT OF MINERS TO A DECENT LIFE

Mr. A. J. Cook Pillories Royalty Owners; A Callous System

MR. J. H. THOMAS AND SUBSIDY

In no industry does Capitalism stand out so prominently in all its callousness and brutality as in mining, declared Mr. A. J. Cook, in speeches in the South Wales coalfield yesterday.

In no other industry was there greater evidence of courage and comradeship. Would any British citizen deny the miner safety and economic security, the right to a decent living wage? Mr. Cook asked a Porth audience.

The recent crisis had brought out the issues clearly. Capitalism had failed to ensure either work or a living wage.

THROTTLING THE NATION

Capitalism was not only causing suffering and starvation to the great mining community, but it was now throttling the nation.

"Changes must take place," declared Mr. Cook. "The workers refuse to be slaves. £115,000 for the Marquis of Bute, £80,000 for the Duke of Northumberland, payment in royalties for those who toil not, while the miner, who risks his life, receives starvation wages, fear of dismissal, daily worry for him and his wife and family.

"This system must be changed, and it is for those that suffer—not the dukes, noblemen, and the millionaires, but for those who toil almost from the cradle to the grave—to organise changes.

"Organised Labour has spoken. Black Friday is wiped out for ever. The coalowners are warning you against the Reds. They claim to be your friends and protectors. Having read carefully the proposals on the pit tops, the mineworkers know the truth of that statement. Their alleged friends are coming out in the open."

THE CLASS WAR

The class war was in evidence, continued Mr. Cook. The coalowners, Cabinet Ministers, all joined in the cry: "Away with the Reds and all will be well."

The Reds were preventing the workers from accepting blessings of lower wages and longer hours from a beneficent master class.

He appealed to the workers to accept the challenge. Constructive proposals that would revolutionise the present system must be brought forward.

The master class would fight every inch of the way. It would use every weapon—the Church, Stage, Press, Parliament—and would resort even to bribery.

The issues were too great for small petty differences. There must be the utmost discipline and loyalty in our Movement, and a real live workers' alliance. Give more power to the General Council, and the T.U.C., and secure 100 per cent. organisation immediately.

Only when there was some great catastrophe was it possible to focus the minds of the public on mining conditions, observed Mr. Cook, but, owing to the fighting DAILY HERALD, other papers were now compelled to give the miners a show.

With the support of the workers victory of the Labour Press was certain.

Speaking at Pentypridd, Mr. Cook said that in the recent crisis the trade unions had shown a power that could compel Cabinets to change their minds and compel a leading statesman to do so, an honourable man, whose greatest asset to the Conservative Party was his sincerity.

With regard to the coming inquiry miners would not be satisfied unless there were sitting on the Commission practical minds connected with the industry. In that connection Mr. Baldwin had made a fatal mistake.

FIGHT WOULD COST MORE

Minister of Mines on Reason for the Subsidy

Colonel Lane-Fox, Minister of Mines, speaking at Thirsk on Saturday, said the cost of the subsidy would be nothing to the loss of trade, poverty and distress that would have resulted from a stoppage.

Many Conservatives, he said, were unhappy about the line the Government took. The Government was not afraid; it took a courageous course, but did not want to cause disaster when conditions were so bad. It was not a humiliating situation.

They did not demand more wages, badly off as they were. They had to fight to resist reduction, and instinctively the mass of the workers in Great Britain decided to stand by them. They had heard members of Parliament and the Prime Minister himself saying that the miners were holding up the community, pointing a pistol at their country, but this, Mr. Clynes declared, was the most portentous nonsense. The miners were attacking nobody. They were defending themselves against attack, and these things said of the miners should have been directed against the owners instead.

The greatest industrial peace agent in this country was the trades union official, and no man was more satisfied than he when a settlement on peaceful lines could be secured in a just way.

MR. THOMAS "NOT HAPPY"

Reflections on Settlement of Mining Dispute

Expressing the hope that the Government would give legislative effect to the report of the Coal-Commission, Mr. J. H. Thomas, M.P., addressing Chester railwaymen yesterday, said that the ultimate solution must be in the form of nationalisation.

But, he said, he could be no party to, and would, in fact, urge railwaymen against, any attempts to bring about nationalisation by industrial means.

There had been a lot of talk about the magnificent victory of the miners, said Mr. Thomas, but he was far from happy over the whole business, and no man should be happy because nothing was more dangerous to the future of this country than when employers of labour and the Government were compelled to concede to force what they refused to concede to reason.

CONCILIATION

He had never hesitated to preach that doctrine, and never had he hesitated to lead railwaymen in the belief that if they could hammer out difficulties in a spirit of conciliation everything was gained by that method.

When the miners first were faced with the employers' terms they came to the conclusion that no body of trade unionists would be able to accept the principle that profit was the first charge on industry.

There was nothing worse or more dangerous than conveying to the working classes the impression that the only means whereby they could get justice was to threaten strikes.

In his judgment, not only was the subsidy wrong, not only could it not succeed, but in the end it would be disastrous to the country.

If the subsidy were to be used to bolster or maintain any one industry and provide an economic wage for the workers in that industry there was no logical reason why it should not be applied to any other industry.

He was not going to be a party to advising railwaymen to withhold their labour and strike to obtain what they would obtain so much more easily by exercising their intelligence and their vote.

When the railwaymen decided to stand behind the miners it was not with a view to forcing their views on nationalisation or as a challenge to the rest of the community, or because they wanted to upset the existing Government. They did it because they felt, as trade unionists, there was a trade union principle involved which had to be defended.

Mr. Maxton on Breakdown of Capitalism

HELPLESS PIGMIES

Workers' Power to Bring New System

Mr. James Maxton, M.P., speaking yesterday at the I.L.P. Summer School, warned the students against the danger of imagining that they had 30, 40, or 50 years in which to work out the Socialist solutions for the problems confronting the world.

"I do not believe in the inevitability of gradualism," said Mr. Maxton. "The development of Capitalism is of such a kind that we are going to be rushed up against critical positions very much more speedily than, in pre-war days, we anticipated.

"The war period has speeded up the evolution of capitalism and left behind it problems which capitalism cannot solve. Sitting in the House of Commons day after day and listening to the Hornes, the Churchills, the Chamberlains and others, touching the various problems that arise, is to be educated into a clear understanding that these men are helpless pigmies in handling the questions which confront them.

OUR MUSSOLINIS

"There is no man among them who has any idea how these problems should be solved, unless it be the few of the Mussolini type, like the Birkenheads, and so on, who believe that the capitalists' problems to-day ought to be solved by grinding down the working classes and lowering their wages to what they consider the competitive level in world trade; men who say they would crush any resistance to that system by definite and deliberate armed force. These are the only people who have a definite plan of handling the situation.

"There is no doubt about it," continued Mr. Maxton, "that on the critical Thursday night when the mining dispute was in the balance there was a strong minority of Tory and Liberal politicians who were all out, to use their own phrase, to fight it out now. It was nothing but the fear of the organised might of the Trade Union Movement that prevented them from taking that course rather than the one they did."

BE READY FOR CRISIS

Mr. Maxton added that he wished to impress upon the workers that they were up against a situation which might at any moment become critical. He was convinced the working classes could beat the capitalist class. By the use of well organised and industrial power they could bring Capitalism to its knees.

He stated that in the last dispute the politician was put right out of the road, and one of the reasons for that was the memory of what happened on Black Friday. There was a definite intention well carried out on the part of the industrial leaders not to allow certain politicians to have a finger in the pie, and the only way to do that was to shut out all the politicians.

IDEAL SUMMER SCHOOL

Socialists' Session at Castle on Banks of Severn

Over 100 students have attended the fortnight's session, which concluded on Saturday, and the lecturers have included Oswald Mosley, Philips Price, H. N. Brailsford, Andrew MacLaren, M.P., Alfred Barnes, M.P., Cecil Wilson, M.P., Walter Ayles, and Minnie Pallister.

The castle is ideally situated on the banks of the Severn, and is within easy reach of the Bristol and Midland areas. Arrangements are being made to hold the school again next year, and it is likely to be the largest Socialist Summer School in the country. The school has been superintended by Capt. W. Scobel, Labour candidate for Bath at the last election.



Numerosa la collaborazione e la scelta sinto-ica: Wandervelde per il Belgio, Nitti per l'Italia, Wirth per la Germania, il trait-d'union naturale fra il grande giornale autonomista e Ginevra.

Giudizi su Lloyd George
La politica del "foot-ball"
e l'Impero britannico

(H. F.). - Continua l'affluenza dal nord degli uomini politici che cercano nella nostra penisola un raggio di sole tra tanto cattivo tempo in tutta l'Europa. E' stato così ieri di passaggio a Roma Mr. Sidney Webb, una delle colonne del Labour Party, già Ministro del Commercio e Industria nel gabinetto Macdonald, e tuttora Presidente dei Trade-Unions inglesi. Il Labirismo inglese, si sa, è socialismo all'acqua di rose: il Webb è una figura calma e borghese, fa pensare piuttosto al nostro Luzzatti che al fiero rivoluzionario che capeggiavano, già, il rivoluzionarismo nostrano.

«Sono qui soltanto di passaggio», mi dice, per andare a far una breve visita in Sicilia; però non ho potuto resistere alla tentazione di fermarmi qui a Roma per rinnovare le mie impressioni della sua magnificenza.

«Non ho ancora veduto l'intervista di Lloyd George; per conto mio credo che bisogna sempre evitare di occuparsi degli affari interni d'una altra nazione. Ma qual che dice Lloyd George oramai non ha più nessuna importanza. Ma sì, l'autorizzo a riferire ciò. Dica ch'io ho detto che egli è un uomo finito. Finito. Ha soltanto 40 seguaci al Parlamento, e alle prossime elezioni questi scompariranno forse del tutto. La sua riforma agricola? Ma se non ne vuol sentire nessuno - né i proprietari, né i contadini, né gli operai agricoli. Egli non controlla più neanche il suo partito il quale, del resto, è sostanzialmente esausto.
