NOTES AND DEFINITIONS

1. LOCAL HOUSING STATISTICS is prepared by the Department of the Environment and the Welsh Office to provide figures for individual local authority areas in a quarterly publication. These figures are taken from returns made by the local authorities and do not include any allowance for missing returns.

Regular tables appearing in each issue (see paragraphs 5 to 8) show cumulative figures within either the calendar year or the financial year.

Supplementary tables on various other housing matters are included as annual data become available and appear in the index on page iv.

2. REGIONAL figures and those for England are estimates allowing for missing returns as published in Housing and Construction Statistics. Figures for counties and individual authorities in England do not allow for missing returns but may include some late returns received after the regional estimates were finalised for publication.

3. DEFINITIONS.

'Local authorities' in this publication are local housing authorities and new town authorities;

'Counties' are the areas specified in the London Government Act 1963 and the Local Government Act 1972; the Isles of Scilly are included with Cornwall for statistical purposes;

'Regions' are the standard regions for statistical purposes, revised following local government reorganisation on 1 April 1974;

'Population': the latest available estimates of the home population published by the Office of Population Censuses and Surveys.

4. ADJUSTMENTS TO EARLIER RETURNS may occasionally result in a negative figure for an individual authority, when, for example, dwellings reported as started are subsequently withdrawn.

5. HOUSEBUILDING. Table 1 shows the building progress of permanent houses and flats, cumulatively within the calendar year.

'Local authorities' housebuilding figures include not only dwellings which they will rent but also those they intend to sell or lease (see para 7). Any dwellings built for an authority outside its own area are included in that authority's figures in Table 1, but Table 2 shows the areas in which these dwellings are situated. Table 3 shows the distribution within and outside Greater London of dwellings started and completed by the Greater London Council or by housing associations assisted by the Greater London Council.

'Other public sector' includes housing for Government departments, county councils and housing associations.

'New towns'. Dwellings built for new town development corporations and the Commission for the New Towns and private sector dwellings built in any English new town on land owned by the corporation or the Commission, are shown only against the name of the new town. All private building within the English new towns up to 2nd quarter 1980 (and in Welsh new towns up to 1st quarter 1983) is shown against the new town and is ALSO included in the figures for the relevant housing authority area.

6. RENOVATIONS. Table 4 deals with completions of local authority and housing association dwelling renovation work for which government assistance in the form of a subsidy or a contribution will be given, including local authority dwellings which have been improved for sale (Table 6), and renovation work by private owners and by tenants for which grants were paid by local authorities. The figures, cumulative within calendar years, are the numbers of dwellings and in the case of conversions these are the total available after completion of the work. Estimated figures for new town dwellings are included in regional totals but are not shown separately.

7. SALES OF DWELLINGS OWNED BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND NEW TOWNS. Tables 5, 6 and 7 provide a full presentation of the sales of dwellings according to type of sale. The Housing Act 1980 extended the provisions under which local authorities and new towns dispose of dwellings, particularly through the 'right to buy' established in Part 1 of the Act which came into force on 3 October 1980. Progress during the financial year of sales to tenants exercising their right to buy is summarised in Table 5 which shows numbers of tenants from whom claims to this right had been received on form RTB1 (no adjustment is made for claims subsequently withdrawn), numbers whose right to buy had been accepted by the authorities on form RTB2, and numbers of completed sales. The figures in Table 5 include sales under shared ownership arrangements, the improvement for sale scheme, for improvement by purchaser and building for sale schemes, but not dwellings sold which have been built on land made available under licence (see paragraph 8).

8. HOUSING LAND DISPOSALS. Table 8 deals with local authorities' sales and disposals under licence of land for housing and in addition sales of dwellings built by private developers on land previously made available by authorities under licence.

9. HOMELESS HOUSEHOLDS. Since the implementation of the Housing (Homeless Persons) Act in December 1977, 'Acceptances' covers those households for whom local authorities assume the responsibility of securing accommodation (either temporary or permanent) under the provisions of the Act. This includes households found to be homeless (or threatened with homelessness within four weeks) and in one of the seven designated 'Priority Need' categories for whom local authorities have a duty to secure accommodation and it also includes any homeless households not in priority need for whom they have nevertheless undertaken to secure accommodation. From the fourth quarter of 1980 a new statistical system was introduced for non-metropolitan authorities and from the second half of 1982 this system was extended to metropolitan authorities. Because of changes in recording practices associated with the new system and definitional problems, results are not strictly comparable with those for earlier periods.

10. HOUSING ACTION AREAS AND GENERAL IMPROVEMENT AREAS. Part II of the Housing Act 1969 (as amended by the Housing Acts 1974 and 1980) confers powers on local authorities in England and Wales to declare general improvement areas for the improvement of areas of older housing to prolong their useful life. Part IV of the Housing Act 1974 (as amended by the Housing Act 1980) introduced the power to declare housing action areas. These areas, which have a five year life, are for the improvement of housing in a poorer state than might be expected in general improvement areas and where adverse living conditions are overlaid with social stress. Appropriate powers have been conferred upon authorities, not available elsewhere, to allow them to pursue their improvement programmes within these areas.

Figures of dwellings improved in HAAs (Table 10) and GIAs (Table 11) are also included in Table 4. Authorities reporting no HAAs or no GIAs are excluded from the relevant table.

11. SYMBOLS USED. The following symbols are used throughout:
.. = not available.
- = nil or less than half the final digit shown.

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INDEX TO ANNUAL HOUSEBUILDING AND RENOVATIONS STATISTICS

Published figures of housebuilding and renovations (Tables 1 and 4) are compiled from the available returns for the relevant period. Revised annual tables incorporating late returns from English authorities are published. However, earlier practice was to count the returns as and when these were received from local authorities, including any late returns for earlier periods, and to make no revisions; although distortions in the national and regional statistics were relatively slight, they could be large in the case of individual authorities which did not report regularly. The change in procedure was implemented for English authorities' housebuilding in 1980 and renovations in 1978 and for Welsh authorities' housebuilding and renovations in 1978.

Issues containing annual figures are listed below; for any authority figures should be taken from the latest issue in which the authority is included.

Publications from the Departments of Environment and Transport

Housing and Construction Statistics — annual

Most of the tables in this reference book on housing and construction topics show how things have changed over the last eleven years; others give detailed analyses for the latest year. The quantity and type of housing built each year, and the size of the stock, improvements and energy conservation, slum clearance, rents and rent rebates, house prices and mortgage payments can all be derived from this publication. It also contains figures on the volume and type of construction work and new orders in Great Britain, the labour market, costs and prices of materials and labour, and the use of materials. Detailed analyses of the activities of private contractors and local authorities direct labour departments are given for recent years.

Housing and Construction Statistics — quarterly

Produced in two parts each quarter, designed to supplement the annual volume by making the latest figures available as quickly as possible.

Local Housing Statistics

Published quarterly, with regular statistics on the progress of housebuilding, house

renovations and council house sales in individual local authorities in England and Wales. Statistics on homeless households, slum clearance and homes specially designed for the chronically sick and disabled are included as they become available.

Commercial and Industrial Floorspace Statistics

Floorspace figures are given for 6 non-domestic use classes (including industrial, commercial offices, and warehouses) by size band and whether changes are the result of demolition, extension, new development or change of use. Additionally, details of the estimated stock of floorspace are available for each use class for regions, counties, and local authority areas.

Digest of Environmental Pollution and Water Statistics

Issued annually, it provides information on the main trends in environmental pollution. Its explanatory text and commentary highlights the trends, gives information on some of the factors likely to influence them and, where appropriate, links series together. It has sections on air pollution, fresh water pollution, marine pollution, noise, waste, and radio-activity. A separate section updates the series on water supply and use.

English House Condition Survey 1981

The survey forms part of a 5 year cycle to collect information needed to help monitor the effectiveness of current housing policies and to aid in the formation of future policy.

Local Government Financial Statistics

This publication presents details of local authority expenditure and income during the last financial year. The main figures relate to local authorities in England, but summary figures are also shown separately for the various types of authority (counties and districts, metropolitan and non-metropolitan) in both England and Wales. Further tables set the total of local authority expenditure in the context of the whole of the national economy, and relate present levels of expenditure with those recorded in earlier years.

Transport Statistics Great Britain

The annual publication is the main reference book for information on all aspects of transport. It includes tables, charts and commentary on personal travel and freight transport by road, rail, pipelines, sea, air and inland waterways. Comparable figures for other industrialised countries are also given. Apart from the main series on the volume and types of traffic, the publication contains information on topics as diverse as commuter traffic, expenditure on transport, energy use, forecasts of traffic and car ownership, driving tests, accidents and vehicle offences.

Road Accidents Great Britain

This annual publication contains detailed analyses of personal injury accidents in the most recent year, complemented by a section which examined trends over the last 11 years (in some cases more). Separate figures are given for each type of road, class of road user, age and sex group, road surface condition, vehicle manoeuvres, day of week

and time of day, etc, as well as indicating the severity of the accident or casualty. Specially written articles draw attention to trends in topical areas.

National Travel Survey Reports

These give statistics of personal travel covering journeys, mileage, time, cost, purpose and mode of travel. Analyses by household income, car ownership, type of area, age/sex of individual, driving licence holding and other individual and household characteristics are shown.
