concerning themselves with the movement &
there is to be a special meeting of final students
here in November - & of part students in the
Spring to discuss the subject. There will be
the general discussion of the suffrage question
& also an attempt to describe the movement

in England, Australia, N. Zealand
USA Etc.

There is to be a suffrag meeting held in
Ottawa this week immediately following
the ^{Annual} meetings of the National Council.

I will gladly forward necessary sums for
your literature. I received me a supply in
February 1906 - but I think there may be
fewer valuable publications since then.

If you can kindly direct me to articles
& publications to be obtained elsewhere
I shall be very grateful.

I want to obtain the literature of the
Anti Suffrag Society also - but am unfortunately
ignorant of their address.

I trust I am not troubling you unduly.
