PREFACE

The object of this handbook is to assist girls and women to obtain suitable hostel accommodation in London, and the list, with a few exceptions, is restricted to those hostels which charge two guineas a week or less.

It is published by the Central Council for the Social Welfare of Girls and Women in London, who feel keenly that it is of great importance to insure that girls living in London can live in healthy surroundings, the term healthy being interpreted as including, not only sanitation, but also a healthy social atmosphere. It is from this point of view that they have undertaken the preparation of this list.

It is not claimed that it is in any way complete, and it is hoped that those interested in the welfare of girls in the Metropolitan area will forward criticisms and suggestions so that future editions of the work may possess added usefulness.

In publishing the third edition of this book the Central Council desire to thank all those who have assisted in its preparation, particularly the officers of the London County Council to whose courtesy and helpful advice they are greatly indebted.
